(5) That this Board respectfully requests the Department to amend the school calendar, so that each term fails within its own quarter, and so that each term normally starts on a Tuesday and requests that each teacher may be supplied with one copy of this calendar at the beginning of the year.

(6) Notice of Question. What is the salary paid by the Department to a male Native teacher who holds no teaching certificate and fails:

(a) in one subject in his N.P.H. final examination?

(b) completely in this final examination?
