Further to your letter of the 6th inst., and our
reply of 10th. inst.

Your contention that a woman in Natal is not al-
lowed by law to get transfer of land in Natal is coorect,
unless ~~they are~~ ^{she is} exempted from the Native Law.

We have been in communication with Col. Collins
M.P., the Managing Director of the Company, who advises us
that he is taking up the matter of the exemption of Native
Women purchasers, with the Government, as he is of the
opinion that all owners of land should be exempted.

Meanwhile the Company is willing to give an
undertaking that if they are unable to give transfer within
a reasonable time the purchase price will be returned to
the purchaser with interest.
