Thank-you for your letter dated 13 August. I hope you have recieved a letter I sent to all our supporters dated 20 July. In it I explained in a bit of detail the position of our campaign and the fact that we are continuing, although changing our medus operandi to meet the new challenge.

Our position financially is that we are alright for the time being. The point about using Trocaire's grant in 1986 was that we had been given the money on the basis of out 1985 application. We only recieved the money in 1986, so it will only be reflected in this years books. At the moment I am in the process of drawing up a budget and project proposal for 1987. I met with Dominique Lessafre of CCFD the other day and on his suggestion will have the application ready for the Cidse meeting at the end of October. Because of the conditions under which we are working, I am hoping that Cidse members will be able to cover the whole application. This will help immensely with the method of getting the money into the country. I am however working on this and will probably inform you of this through CIIR. I am doing this as I want to mimimise the amount of foreign mail I send out of the country with that kind os sensitive information.

I would also like to inform you that I am in the process of putting a package of material together to go to all those who have supported us in the past. This will give you some idea of how we are functioning.

I think that is about all for now.





I am sorry if we have not responded in time to your letter to Lesley Liddell. I still have not got the letter from her that you sent, dated 4 September. However from your letter (25 November) it seems that Trocaire has approved a grant of IR£ I 500 for our I985 budget. In terms of this you may transfer the funds as for the I986 budget ie deposits may be made into the account of the Southern African Catholic Bishops Conference, marking them for ECC.

In terms of a report for I985 I would like to inform you that the ECC will be involved in a major conference of evaluation of I985 and planning for I986 at the end of January. This conference involves the participation of 20 elected representatives from each of the 6 regions. As soon as the reports of that conference are compiled I will send them to you. At the same time a full set of audited accounts will be compiled. I will also send these to you, so that you have a clear idea of how money has been used.

In terms of SA law, once we have recieved monies from you, we will send you a copy of an agreement for your signature. This serves to protect us from prosecution under the fundraising act. I hope this will not inconvenience you.

I hope this serves to clear up some of the misunderstandings.

I hope you and all others, particularly Dee, at Trocaire are well. Please send my love to all especially over this Christmas season.
