If any Error be found to have been committed in the Form or Substance of any Entry in the Register Books respectively, such Error shall and may, within One Month after the discovery thereof, be altered and corrected, according to the Truth of the case, by the Minister who made such Entry, and solemnized the Ceremony to which the same relates, in the presence of the Parents of the Child whose Baptism may have been entered in such Register, -or of the to the Truth of the Parties married, -or in the presence of the Parties who shall have attended at any Burial, -to which such erroneous Entry shall relate; or, in case of the Death or Absence of the respective Parties aforesaid, then in the presence of the Churchwardens (who shall respectively attest the same); and such Alteration and Correction shall be made in the Margin of the Book in which such erroneous Entry shall have been made, without any Alteration or Obliteration of the original Entry; and the Minister shall sign such Correction, and add to such Signature the Day of the Month and Year when such Correction shall be made; and the fair Copy of the Registers which shall be transmitted to the Registrar of the Diocese shall contain an exact Transcript of the original Entry, and of such Correction.
