Hier is soveel beskuldigdes en 'n mens kan nooit oorsigtig wees nie. Ja?

MNR. VAN PITTIUS: Nou weet u waar na toe hy geduik het of wat? --- Die tyd toe ek hom onderstebo geloop het het hy bo-oor 'n blou oorpak geval wat by die kopenente gelê het van waar hy en die ander jong Bantoeman geslaap het. Ten opsigte van by watter een se kopenent het dit gelê? --- Dit was daar by beskuldigde no.4 se kopenent.

Nou wat het toe gebeur? --- Nadat beskuldigde no.4 so half aan die linkerkant geval het het hy weer half orent gekom en beweeg daar na waar die wapens was, gelê het.

Na die rigting waar die wapens was? --- Dit is korrek. (10

Nou het u die persoon wat saam met no.4 daar in die hut was, sal u hom herken, het u hom gesien? --- Ek het hom gesien.

Nou ek toon aan u foto BEWYSSSTUK R. Kan u sê of u daardie persoon al gesien het of nie? --- Dit is die Bantoeman wat saam met beskuldigde no.4 in die hut was.

Weet u miskien uit eie kennis, nie wat u gehoor het of soiets nie, maar uit eie kennis wat sy naam is? --- Ek weet nie wat sy naam is nie, uit eie kennis nie.

Nou het u daarna vertrek van die toneel af? --- Dit is korrek, U Edele. (20

Wat het u gedoen met die persoon op Bewysstuk R en die beskuldigde no.4? --- Dit is alles aan Luitenant De Waal oorhandig en hy het verder gehandel daarmee.

Nou beskuldigde no.1 voor die hof, herken u hom? Het u hom al voorheen gesien? --- Dit is korrek, ek het hom gesien vantevore.

Wanneer het u hom vir die eerste keer gesien? --- Ek het hom vir die eerste keer gesien op die 1e dag van Januarie 1977.

Die 1e Januarie 1977? --- Dit is korrek.

En het u hom daarna weer gesien? --- Dit is korrek. (30

Waar? --- Te John Vorster Plein.

Kan u vertel wat u daar gemerk het, wat u daar agtergekome het? --- Dit was toe die beskuldigdes oorgeplaas is na Pretoria, vir verdere ondersoek hier gewees.

Kan u voortgaan? --- Ek het twee ringe van beskuldigde no.1 ontvang.

Waar het u die ringe ontvang, waar het u dit gesien? --- Die ringe is deur beskuldigde no.1 van sy hand afgehaal en aan my oorhandig.

Het u dit self gesien aan hom? --- Dit is korrek.

Watter hand was dit, watter vinger? Of kan u nie onthou (10) nie? --- Ek kan nie dit nou so onthou nie.

U sê u het self gesien dat hy dit afhaal? --- Dit is korrek.

Was dit op versoek van uself, of wat? --- Dit is korrek.

En toe? Wat het u met die ringe gemaak? --- Die ringe is daarna aan kolonel Booysen oorhandig.

Nou hierdie plek in die Nebo distrik waar na toe julle gegaan het /...



gegaan het dit is 'n hut, nie waar nie? --- Nee, dit is 'n klomp hutte in 'n eenheid.

Ja, daar is geen elektriese ligte in daardie omgewing nie? --- Dit is korrek.

Dit was natuurlik baie donker gewees? --- Hy was darem nie baie donker nie, maar ons het flitsligte ook gehad.

Ja, julle het flitsligte gehad maar daar was geen lig behalwe die flitsligte gewees nie? --- Dit is korrek. As ek dit reg kan onthou was dit darem nie donkermaan gewees nie. (10

En dit was nou om en by 3.30 in die oggend gewees? --- Dit is korrek.

En alles wat in daardie hut plaasgevind het het baie vinnig gebeur, nie waar nie? --- 'n Mens kan amper sê, ja.

Want onmiddellik toe u die hut ingegaan het het u gesê Bafana? --- Dit is korrek.

En hierdie man het opgespring? --- Dit is korrek.

Het hy daarop geantwoord? --- Hy het ontken dat hy Bafana is

Wat was sy woorde gewees? --- Ek kan nie sy presiese woorde onthou nie. (20

Op watter manier het hy ontken dat hy Bafana was? --- Ek kan wel sê hy het sy kop ook geskud maar hy het iets gesê ook, U Edele.

U kan nie onthou wat het hy gesê nie? --- Ek kan nie meer onthou nie.

Kan u onthou in watter taal hy gepraat het? --- Hy het Engels gepraat.

Nou u sê u het hom onderstebo geloop. Hoe het u dit gedoen? Het u hom gestamp of wat het u gedoen? --- Soos wat 'n rugby speler 'n ander een sal onderstebo loop. (30

Tackle? --- Nee, nie juis "tackle" nie, meer onderstebo loop.



Met jou skouer? --- Ek kan nie sê dit was met my skouer nie, maar ek weet ek het hom onderstebo geloop.

Julle het verwag dat julle vuurwapens daar sal vind? --- (10) Dit is korrek.

Maar toe jy in die hut ingaan het jy dit nie uitgeneem nie? --- Nee, U Edele.

Jy het net 'n flitslig in jou hand gehad? --- Dit is korrek.

En ek neem aan dat jy was van plan om hierdie persoon so vinnig soos moontlik in hegtenis te neem? --- Dit is korrek.

Voordat enige skietery kon plaasvind? --- Dit is korrek.

En waar was die flitsig gewees gedurende hierdie geskarrel wat plaasgevind het? --- Ek glo hy was in my hand gewees.

Nie die hele tyd op die beskuldigde nie want jy het beweeg? --- Ja, maar die flitslig van my is snaaks, waar jy hom trek verlig, ongeag na watter rigting dit geskyn is.

Wat het die ander persoon die hele tyd gedoen terwyl jy met beskuldigde no.4 besig was? --- Dit sal hy kan antwoord.

Kan u nie sê nie? --- Ek kan nie sê wat hy alles gedoen (10) het nie.

Het hy daar gelê of opgestaan of probeer keer of wat het hy gedoen? --- U bedoel nou die ander Bantoeman wat ..?

Ja? --- Ja, ek weet hy het geskrik en hy het daar rondbeweeg in die kamer maar wat hy presies gedoen het kan ek nie oor getuig nie.

En De Waal, wat het hy gedoen? --- Soos ek gesê het hy kan daardie getuienis gee, ek kan nie sê wat hy presies gedoen het nie.

Was hy bewusteloos of het hy ... (tussenbei).. --- Hy was nie bewusteloos nie, maar sy gô was so 'n bietjie uit seker. (30)

Is dit nie korrek, sersant, dat nadat jy die naam Bafana genoem het, het jy ook gevra waar is die vuurwapens nie? ---

Dit/...



Dit is moontlik, Edele, ek kan nie dit onthou nie. Ek glo nie ek het so gevra nie, maar die moontlikheid is daar.

Want jy het na vuurwapens gesoek? — Dit is reg, U Edele.

So dit is moontlik dat jy vir vuurwapens kon gevra het? — Dit is korrek, maar ek kan nie onthou dat ek soiets gevra het nie.

Beskuldigde no.4 sê, sersant, dat jy het nie geduik soos jy beskryf het nie, maar dat nadatjy die naam Bafana geroep het, en vir vuurwapens gevra het, het jy hom toe - het hy ontken, en toe het jy hom hom onderstebo gestamp? — Dan sou(10) hy 'n aanranding klagte gemaak het as hy so gevoel het, so ek ontken dit.

Jy ontken dit. En daarna het alles baie vinnig gebeur? — Ons kan so sê.

Jy sê dat jy in hierdie leertas gekyk het? — Ek het nie op daardie oomblik self in die leertas in hom in gekyk nie, U Edele.

EXAMINATION BY MR. DONEN:

BY THE COURT: Tyrone, when you came here just now into court you asked that your evidence be heard in camera. Counsel has had a discussion between themselves, and in terms of that agreement I will order that your name should not be published and that no information be published which may lead to your (10) identification. --- I understand.

Do you now feel free to give your evidence? --- I feel free.

MR. DONEN ALSO ASKS THE COURT TO WARN THE WITNESS IN TERMS OF SECTION 254.

BY THE COURT: As you have heard I have been informed by the Prosecutor that in his opinion you are an accomplice of the accused in this case. And as an accomplice you will be obliged to answer questions which may tend to incriminate you. If however you answer the questions fully to my satisfaction you will not be prosecuted, but be given free pardon as you call it. --- I understand. (20)

MR. DONEN: Do you know accused no.3 before the court? --- I do.

BY THE COURT: Will you just stand up please. --- That is the man, My Lord.

MR. DONEN: Now when did you meet him and where did you meet him? --- I met him during 1975 at Mozambique.

Can you remember when in 1975? --- Approximately March month.

And under what circumstances did you meet him? --- We (30) were at/...



were at a funeral.

Were you introduced to him? --- He introduced himself to me.

As whom? --- As Jacob.

Did he have any surname? --- Mokwena.

Did you have any conversation with him? --- Yes, we did.

Could you relate that conversation to the court? Did he tell you anything about himself? --- Yes, he told me that he comes from South Africa, went through Swaziland.

Speak a little bit louder, please. --- And stayed in Mozambique as a refugee. And he told me that he is waiting (10 for the ANC people for training.

Did he say what sort of training? --- He did not tell me what training, because he said that he is old.

Did he say where he would go for this training? --- He did not exactly tell me where, but told me that the ANC trains everywhere.

Did he say where everywhere was? --- Like Tanzania, Russia, China or possibly in Mozambique.

Did he say anything else about himself on that day? --- (20 No, he did not tell me all on that same day. We did meet again.

Where did you meet again? --- At Avenida da Brazil at a refugee flat.

And what did he tell you there? --- He told me that he had met Lennox, a member of the ANC. Accused no.3 said that the ANC members leave all the messages with him.

Did he tell you anything else about himself? --- He was not talking to me directly, but with us meanwhile we were together with him.

And what did he say? --- He said that during or before (30 1960 when they used to place pamphlets on the walls the members of the PAC would come and remove those pamphlets from



the walls. And further he told me that he was not on good terms with them.

Alright, now you said that this Avenida da Brazil was a refugee flat. What was accused no.3's function at that flat? --- Because he is an old member of the ANC, when the ANC members arrive, they always contact him, would sit down and sing songs.

What sort of songs? --- Freedom songs.

Such as? --- "Kosi sikelelo e Afrika, Nanci indoda emnyama", and the others which I cannot remember. (10

I don't know how good my pronunciation is, but does this mean anything to you "Mandela umfuni amajoni inkululeko"? --- It means to me that Mandela wants soldiers who will come and fight in South Africa.

We will leave that point. Do you know who Keith Mokoape is? --- I do.

Who and what is he? --- He stands for the ANC at Botswana he looks after the people as refugees and helps them join the ANC.

Now have you ever met him? --- Yes, three times. (20

Where have you met him? --- At first I met him at Tanzania, I secondly met him at Angola, thirdly I met him at Botswana.

Where in Tanzania did you meet him? --- At Themeke.

And what is Themeke? --- It is a district.

And then where in Angola did you meet Keith Mokoape? --- At the National camp, at the Fabla National camp.

What is that? --- It is the Angola Armed Forces Camp.

Do you know somebody called Lennox? --- I do.

What is he? --- He stands for the refugees in Mozambique, refugees who have come to join the ANC.

Have you ever met him? --- I have. (30

Where?/...



Where? --- At Mozambique, at Maputo.

I have no more questions, My Lord.

MR. CHASKALSON: My Lord, I have in fact no instructions on this witness seeing that he is a man not previously encountered. May I suggest he stand down until tomorrow?

MR. DONEN HAS NO OBJECTION TO THE WITNESS STANDING DOWN.

BY THE COURT: The witness will stand down until tomorrow.

EXAMINATION BY MR. DONEN: My Lord, I also ask that the name (10 of this witness be not published. Mr. Chaskalson has no objection

BY THE COURT: In this instance like in some other instances, by agreement it is ordered that the name of this witness is not to be published, nor is anything to be published which may tend to lead to his identification.

MR. DONEN ALSO ASKS THE COURT TO WARN THE WITNESS IN TERMS OF SECTION 254.

BY THE COURT: Titi, you heard the Prosecutor telling me that in his opinion you are an accomplice in this case. As an accomplice you will be obliged to answer questions that may tend to (20 incriminate you. If you however answer the questions fully to my satisfaction you will not be prosecuted, but you will be discharged from criminal liability. ---I understand.

MR. DONEN: Before your arrest were you a member of an organisation known as the Soweto Students Representative Council? --- Yes, Lord.

For how long were you a member? --- I can't remember but quite a long time.

Do you know accused no.2 before the court? --- Yes, I do.

BY THE COURT: Accused no.2, will you just stand up please. --- (30

That is /...



That is the man.

MR. DONEN: Did you see accused no.2 during December of 1976?

--- Yes, I did see him.

Where did you see him? --- I saw him at Mafulo Location in Soweto.

Were you alone when you saw him? --- There were four of us including him.

Now who were the other two besides you and him? --- Easy and Khotso.

What is Easy's surname and Khotso's surname? --- Gxuluwe.(1)

And Khotso? --- Seatlholo.

Now were they members of any organisation? --- Yes, they were.

Of which organisation? --- SSRC.

Does that stand for the Soweto Students Representative Council.

Now where was it that you met accused no.2? --- We met at Obed's house.

And did you speak to no.2? --- I personally did not.

Did no.2 speak to you or any of your company? --- Yes, he(2) spoke to the company in which I was.

And what did he have to say? --- He wanted to train us.

Did he say train you in what? --- For the struggle.

What sort of - how did he want to train you for the struggle? --- He made mention of ammunition.

To what struggle was he referring? --- The struggle that was during that time.

What struggle was during that time? --- Actually he wanted to help us, we students.

Help you how? --- (Pause).

Did he say how he wanted to help you? --- No, he did not sa



What else did he say? --- He discussed about the fact that he wanted to train us.

What did he have to say? --- (Court intervenes).

BY THE COURT: Tell me, why do you seem so hesitant to answer the questions? --- Simply because I have forgotten a lot of things.

MR. DONEN: Now can you remember what he said to you about the training? --- I don't remember.

Does the word "cell" mean anything to you? --- Accused no.2 said he would train us as a cell. (10)

Yes, and what else did he have to say? --- Like what?

Well, you are the one who was there? --- I don't remember.

Now what happened when you finished ... (Court intervenes).

BY THE COURT: Can you remember whether the word "cell" was used at all? --- Yes, he used the word "cell".

MR. DONEN: Now what happened when you finished your discussion? --- He left.

And did you see him again? --- I saw him the following day.

Now where did you see him? --- If I remember well we went to fetch him at Kwezi Station. (20)

Did you fetch him by arrangement? --- Yes, by arrangement we fetched him.

And who is "we"? --- Myself, Easy and Khotso and Jonas Machobane.

Now where did you go from the station? --- We went to Mpetla Location.

And what did you do there? --- We discussed about things.

What did you discuss? --- If I remember well we were discussing about our organisation. Accused no.2 then told us about the cell system. (30)

Now what did he tell you about the cell system? --- I can't remember/...



remember the exact words because I have forgotten a lot of things.

Did he tell you whose cell system it was that he was talking about? --- He said he can make use of the cell system by training us before, he will train us because we had agreed that we will be under them as individuals.

Now who is "we", and who is "them"? --- Myself, Easy, Khotso, Jonas.

Under who would you be? --- He was explaining how the cell works. And that he would train us before. That is (1) why I said we would be under him.

Yes, now who is "our" organisation that you were discussing was that the SSRC? --- Yes.

And what did you discuss about the SSRC? --- I don't remember well.

What happened then after you finished discussing the cell system? --- Accused no.2 showed us a machine-gun and said it is a Scorpion.

Now I will show you EXHIBIT 52. Have you ever seen anything similar before? --- But not exactly this one. (2)

In any case, what ... (Court intervenes).

BY THE COURT: What do you mean not exactly this one, do you mean it is similar but not exactly this one? --- Yes, similar to this one.

MR. DONEN: Now firstly where did he get the Scorpion from? --- I don't know.

Where did he - did it appear out of thin air or did he take it out somewhere? --- When we had gone to fetch him he brought it along with him.

Now what did he do with that Scorpion? --- He dismantled (3) it, and we also did likewise.

And then?/...



And then? --- We also dismantled it and assembled it as shown. When we had finished we gave it back to him.

BY THE COURT: Now just tell me, where this took place, where the Scorpion was shown to you, where were you? In a house, in a street, in the veld, or what sort of area were you in when the Scorpion was displayed to you? --- We were in a house at Jonas Machobane.

Where he showed that to you in the house, I take it it was in a room? And were there only the people you have mentioned or were there other people present when the Scorpion was displayed? --- There were no other people.

MR. DONEN: Now after you finished assembling and dismantling(10 the Scorpion, what happened next? --- Accused no.2 showed us a hand grenade. He had brought it along with him.

Yes, now what did he show you about it? --- He unscrewed it. I saw the detonate. He showed us a pin. When one wants to use it, one pulls up the pin. And then you throw it, it will then work.

Did he say who you throw it at, accused no.2? --- I can say to the target, I don't remember.

Now did any of you handle this hand grenade? --- We all handled it. (20

I show you EXHIBIT 29, EXHIBIT 28. --- Yes, it is similar to this which I now see.

BY THE COURT: That is the pineapple. Yes?

MR. DONEN: Now why did you handle these weapons? --- I was interested to know them.

And why did accused no.2 show you these weapons? --- Because he knew that we were interested in them.

Did you agree to work in a cell under him? --- Yes, I did agree to work in a cell under him.

And the other people present? --- Yes. the other people (30



too agreed.

In what capacity? In your private capacity? --- In the private capacity.

Now did accused no.2 tell you anything about himself? --- Like what?

Like whose weapons these were and where he got them? --- What was the question?

Did accused no.2 say where he got the weapons or whose weapons they were? --- We knew as an ANC member.

Now how did you know? --- Because he said that he is a (10 member of the ANC.

And this cell to which you referred, does that cell relate to any organisation? --- Yes.

To which organisation? --- Umkhonto We Sizwe.

Now what was said about Umkhonto We Sizwe? --- Really I can't remember.

Do you know what the ANC is? --- Yes, I do.

Was anything discussed about the ANC during all the time you saw accused no.2? --- I think we did but I can't remember.

Now when you spoke about Umkhonto We Sizwe, just before (20 you said that, you said MK to the interpreter, is that correct? --- Yes.

Are these two the same? --- One and the same.

CROSS-EXAMINATION BY MR. CHASKALSON: I think as I understand your evidence, he showed you these weapons? --- Yes.

He allowed you to handle them? --- Yes.

He explained what use could be made of them? --- Yes.

He told you that you would have to behave in a disciplined way? --- Yes.

And that if and when the time came to use those weapons (30 you would be told? --- I don't remember.



You don't remember that. I have no further questions.

RE-EXAMINATION BY MR. DONEN: No questions.

BY THE COURT: Tell me, what is your age? --- 22 Years old.

You say you can't remember how long you had been a member of the Students Organisation before this meeting with accused no.2? --- I can't remember.

Was it anything like four years or two years, or had you just become a member? --- One or two years, I don't remember.

You say you were a member of the SSRC, did you serve on (1 any governing body, were you the chairman or were you just an ordinary member, or did you have any position? --- A member of the Executive.

Now what position did you hold in the Executive? --- We had no positions there.

Now in your Executive they were all of the same status? --- We had not gone so far as to give each positions.

And the other two people, or three who were with you, did they also serve on the Executive, or were they just ordinary members? --- Khotso was the present, and the others merely (2 members.

Members of the Executive, or just ordinary members of the organisation? --- One of them was a member of the Executive.

Who was he? --- Easy.

Tell me, during 1976, in which form or standard were you at that stage? --- Form 3.
