- Participation on ad hoc committees
- Co-ordination of internal education + training (through Contact Committee)
- Administration, correspondence + post
- Co-ordination of minute-taking

4. PUBLICITY OFFICER (OR PRESS OFFICER OR PUBLICITY SECRETARY)

- Liaison with press, radio + other media
- Co-ordination of press conferences + press statements
- Writing of occasional articles

5. TREASURER

- Keep local ECC books
- Liaise with National Treasurer re national finances
- Co-ordination of ECC fund-raising
