Dear Chief Selas

The Women's Mwanano Convention will open on Tuesday morning, Sept 26th. at 10 o'clock in the Star Church.

Mr. Lee & the ministers will be there then and it would give to me & all the women very great pleasure if you could arrange to be with us then.

I have had a letter today telling me that already 200 women have applied for the concession ticket we have arranged for from all over the Transvaal & Swaziland. As we are expecting about that number also from Mafeking & this district you will see what an important gathering of women this is to be.

I have been with the women for their annual convention for the past 10 years. Wherever we go we are made to feel how heartily we are welcomed but I am sure no warmer welcome has ever been given to us than is being given by Mafeking.

I hope very much to see you on Tuesday, 26th. at 10 o'clock.
