Mrs. Robertson, the new Housekeeper arrived at 3.45 with her son - S.I.B. showed her the ropes.

Mrs. Byron stayed the night.

Father Millington said Mass (Father Thomas ill) he brought Joseph an ordinand to serve his. Noira Susan Collins + Mrs. Byron were at Mass.

4th, Father Jarvis Palmer said Mass -

Builders returned + got to work on Hall.

Mrs. Robertson started work

S. Dorothy finished painting.

6th, Arch. Steph. said Mass - Mrs. Wellbeloved.

We all went to Rodepoort for a picnic with the J.H.B. Sisters - Sister Dorothy left us.

The Roof wetting party.

7th. Father Williams said Mass.
The roof finished. Herbert Snyder called on his way back from Pilgesprint.

8th. Mother P & Sister Katryn came to lunch & tea.
Doctor Booker came to see Sister I.B.'s foot & put her to bed! Father Williams said Mass.
Miss Pim rang about Miss Cantrell of W.F.A.W. who wants a matron's job. Mrs. Welbeloved took her to Norwood.

9th. Father Williams said Mass. Sent for Doctor to see S.I.B. (very swollen)

9th. Sister Elsa came to stay for a week - fetched by Mrs. Welbeloved.

10. Father Williams said Mass - S.I.B. very poorly. Doctor Booker came. Later Sister Esme dropped in (by mistake!) Father Thomas brought Sister Elsa over for a week - About 6 p.m. Sister Katryn & Dorothea Farksen came. Mother P. had sent them so that Dorothea could stay & help look after S.I.B. Mrs. Well. also came.

Leah 3rd S.L.s. Dr. H. Davis, S. Williams, C. Frank. Pounding, R. Thwaites, S. Keise, B. Privett, R. Thwaites. The Matron made curtains for the new dormitories. S.C. sent to bed to rest. S. Ibra went away.
17. Sund. Dr. Thomas said Mass. Matron continued their curtains all day! Miss Seaton arrived 6 p.m. - new Matron. S.C. to rest again 3 p.m. onwards. S. Phoebe landed Cape Town.
18. Monday. Dr. Williams for Mass. Parents. Mr. Parkington Mr. Ellwood. Mr. Osborne. Sister Viola Sister Christina returned very late from East London by car - delayed by leaking radiator.
