General Notarial Bond.

Know all men whom it may concern that on this the ~ seventh ~ day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and four before me Spencer Minchin of Mafeking in the Colony of the Cape of Good Hope, Notary Public by lawful authority duly admitted and sworn and in the presence of the subscribed witnesses personally came and appeared Silas Tawana Molema of Mafeking aforesaid who acknowledged himself to be truly and lawfully indebted to and on behalf of Charles Wenham of Mafeking in the sum of three hundred pounds sterling (£300) of lawful money arising from money duly lent and advanced to him by the said Charles Wenham.

Wherefore the said appeared renouncing all benefits from the legal exception non numeratae pecuniae and any other exception either in law or equity which might be pleaded in bar to the validity of the said debt promised and undertook to pay or cause to be paid to the said Charles Wenham his order heirs administrators or assigns at his office in Mafeking the aforesaid sum of £300 sterling on the

the 15th day of March 1905 together with interest reckoned from the 15th day of September 1904 at the rate of ten per centum per annum and to continue to be so reckoned until such time as the whole of the aforesaid capital sum shall be fully paid off.

And for securing the payment of the aforesaid capital sum the Appearer declared to bind specially the following live stock the bona fide property of the Appearer

2. _____ 35 head of mixed cattle at present at Madibi in the district of Mafeking more particularly described in the schedule hereto

4. _____ 30 head of mixed cattle at present at Pilsani in the Bechuanaland Protectorate more particularly described in the schedule hereto

which stock the said Charles Wenham shall be at liberty on the said Appearer being sued in any Court of Law whereby the said property may in consequence be attached

and also in the event of the non payment of the said capital sum and interest on due date (anything to the contrary hereinbefore contained notwithstanding) immediately to seize and sell or otherwise dispose of or so much of the said property as will realize the amount of the said capital sum and interest due thereon and all expenses of such sale or disposal; provided that after the total amount due shall have been paid out of the proceeds aforesaid the balance thereof together with the remainder if any shall be paid and delivered to the said Appearer or his Order.

And for the purposes aforesaid the said Appearer declared hereby further to nominate constitute and appoint the said Charles Wenham to be his true and lawful attorney and Agent irrevocably and in rem suam as long as any part of the said capital sum or interest thereon shall remain unpaid with power of substitution and promise of approbation according to law and the appearer also further declared to refrain during the continuance and currency of this Bond from selling or pledging by delivery or otherwise any or all of the property aforesaid or any increase thereto or specially to mortgage

or hypothecate the same to any creditor or creditors for debt or otherwise.

And the appearer finally declared to bind generally his person and all his property both such as he is already or may in future become possessed of moveable and immoveable without exception submitting the whole of the same and the choice thereof to constraint and execution as the law directs.

Thus done and passed at Mateking aforesaid the day month and year first aforewritten in the presence of Gloff Martinus Bergh and Allen Sidney Geen both of Mateking.
