Some of the workers have been arrested and sentenced, others endorsed out of Durban. The United Tobacco Company continues to make huge profits from the non-Europeans on the sales of their cigarettes and tobacco.

WORKERS, THEY ARE DETERMINED TO FIGHT FOR
THEIR RIGHTS TO THE BITTER END.

PRODUCED BY THE UNITED TOBACCO COMPANY
