April 16 <sup>th</sup>	Maundy Thursday	Evensong was said in chapel - it was quite finished inside & the new altar was moved in and all the Vestry furniture & chapel furniture - The Wobch was kept in chapel and all offices - The temporary chapel being completely dismantled.
" 5 <sup>th</sup>	Good Friday	The Stations of the Cross were said at the Calvary.

Cross, Candelsticks &amp; flowers on the re-table. at 6.30 Fr. Hill had service for some of the P.C.H.S &amp; boy scouts who were camping out. at 7.30 Fr. Hill heard 3 Confessions. Miss Tompson, Ethel &amp; Emily. 1<sup>st</sup> Vespers of Easter at 8 - It was to have been at 7.30 but put off because of Confessions</p>
.. 7 <sup>th</sup>	<u>Easter Day</u>	<p>Choral Mass with Incense at 7.30. The Easter offerings altogether came to £ 3. Fr. Hill preached at Matins. Evensong was at 8 because a tremendous storm swamped the choir. Compline was at 8.45. Prime Easter Monday Tuesday 8.45. Matins &amp; Teneo at 9.</p>
