Excellency the Governor and High Commissioner
undertakes on behalf of Her Majesty the
Queen that from and after your death half
the amount of your present pension that
is to say £150 a year, will be paid
to your successor in the Chieftainship for
his life if he shall so long retain the
Chieftainship of the Potatlili Barony
and will cease and determine on his ceasing
to be such Chief. It is to be understood that
