PUBLICITY

- Don't through it open (banning) but assume the state KNOWS
- Go for INDIVIDUALS WE KNOW
- No register must leave objector until you are sure.

NUMBERS ARE IMPORTANT = 1000 IS OUR GOAL

IMPACT ON PUBLIC IS ESSENTIAL

- EACH PAST OBJECTOR MUST TRY TO GET 5.
- CAMPUS MUST PRODUCE MORE
- COMMUNITY SERVERS MUST GET COVERED
- CHURCHES MUST BE COVERED.

Zimbabwe (Andohi'), Namibia (W. CAPE) and Exiled have been covered.

EXILED: Statement of support or as one in temporary exile !!.
<MORE NEEDS TO BE RESOLVED>

- A statement of OBJECTION IS ESSENTIAL
- Launch register of objectors + state, "OF THESE EXILE RO'S ... due for call up"
- Exiles can have their own Press conference.

STATEMENTS: STATEMENTS TO BE LODGED WITH LAWYERS (^{IDENTIFIED TO OTHER REGIONS})
ONE central LIST IN Jhb.

TYPE OF LAUNCH

- SYMBOLIC PLACE (GRAVEYARD) (Pretoria monument)
claim Namibian deaths by honouring them
- NATIONAL LAUNCH WITH REGIONAL STANDS
- SYMBOLIC PEOPLE TO BE THERE
- NO date to be given just say "round the dot of the call up"

Overall Goal: to contribute to the end of apartheid
and the creation of a nonracial democracy by undermining
the ability of the SADF to defend apartheid.

In order to achieve this goal it was agreed that the
creation of a new broad anti-conscription organisation
was necessary.

By the end of the weekend consensus was reached
on the following:

- the creation of a new organisation with conscription as the focus, but also flowing into broader anti-militarization issues
- ECC should not be revived, but continue symbolically as a ghost or shell organisation. Begins to decide on appropriate ECC profile + actions, bearing in mind possible impact on new org.
- anti-apartheid stance
- early form as an alliance
- positive focus
- a campaigning organisation

FORM:

- a social movement (inclusive of age, class, gender, etc),
acting in public arena; open face (^{ie} not a committee/union/leg)
- bilingual

TARGET: • white community (primarily)
• with conscripts as a special focus; as they have been
the gap in past work, + most closely related to
the SADF, they will form the primary constituency

AIM: LONG-TERM : Set up an anti-conscription organisation,
which is not yet in existence

SHORT-TERM : consult a broad range of individuals,
groups + orgs about - nature of new org
- their participation

RESPONSIBILITY : Regional AMF, with national co-ordination

METHOD :
• open-ended + minded
• inclusive - ie approach ~~at~~ widest possible
range - let them exclude themselves if they
want
• bottom line - anti-apartheid
- anti-conscription

PROCESS :
1) regional consultation
2) national "
3) consultative conference (in March 1990)
4) Launch (± June 1990)

INTERIM :
• raise issue of conscription with urgency
• place it on orgs' agendas
• regional task
