

Resolutions passed at an A.N.C. YOUTH LEAGUE public meeting held on Thursday evening, 10/2/1955 at the T.C. White hall; attended by 1500 people.

1. This meeting of the A.N.C. YOUTH LEAGUE held on the 10th February, 1955, pledges its solidarity with, and support for the stand taken by the people of Sophiatown to resist the Removal scheme and will endeavour by all means to meet them in their stand to resist this iniquitous scheme but condemns the treacherous act embarked upon by those families who betrayed the African people and agreed to the Removal scheme.
2. This meeting warns the government to withdraw the police force patrolling the streets of Sophiatown immediately and in view of the above mentioned factors threatening the people's peace in their fatherland, is convinced that S.A. is a fascist police state.
3. That the statement made by Mr. Swart the so-called Minister of Justice in S.A. indicating that the Sophiatown Africans are armed with machine guns, stern guns, pistols etc. is false and purposely designed as an excuse to command the armed police force to open fire against unarmed Africans.
4. Because it regards it as an act of unwarranted interference, this meeting demands the immediate release of Mr. Robert Resha, President -General of the A.N.C. YOUTH LEAGUE.  
Furthermore, this meeting supports the decision taken by the A.N.C., the mother body to hold a public Divine National Service on the 12th February, 1955 as <sup>a</sup> means of offering prayers to the Almighty to guide us in these troublous times as well as a declaration of its objection to the iniquitous Removal scheme which must be brought to an untimely end.



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(4) The withdrawal of children from school must be intensified in all centres and the Youth League must play a leading part in the struggle to defeat this Slave Education which is designed to enslave the children of Afrika. Furthermore, Conference appeals to the mother-body (A.N.C.) to issue a directive with regard to this question so that strong measures are taken ~~tethetowards~~ these Government plans.

(5) The Freedom Charter must be popularised by educating the youth on the demands of the people as set out in the Charter and to win their support for the realisation of the Peoples demands.

Further, all branches must take note of the following:-

(a) Preparations must be made to call branches of the Youth League to Annual General-Meetings where Office-bearers for 1956 will be elected.

(b) All names and addresses of the officials elected for 1956 must be sent to the Provincial Secretary. These general-meetings for conducting elections must be completed through-out the Cape by the 5th February, 1956.

#### RESOLUTIONS:

(1) Le Ngqungquthela ka Vukayibambe ku Phondo lwe Kapa igqiba ukuba isebe nzele ukuzaliseka emZantsi Afrika kweemfuno neminqweno yabahlali nabantu belilizwe ebalwe kuNqulu weNkululeko owanikelwa kwiNgqungquthela yaBantu ebihlangene eRautini, eKlip-town ngeye Silimela (June) ngomhla we26 ne 27 kulo nyaka ka 1955. Ingqungquthela izimisela ngokuphelelevo ukuba uPhondo lwe Kapa maluphume emagqabini kwindima elusikelwe vona kugqatso loku -qokelela amagama abantu babe sisigidi (one Million) abaxhasa u'qu -lu we Nkululeko ngokwesiqibo semibutho yeSizwe yabantu bomZantsi Afrika.

(2) Le Ngqungquthela ichasene nokugqogqwa komButho we Sizwe namahlakani awo namapolisa kutsha nje, kuba ngolugqogqo u Rulumente ebejonge kuuphela:-

(i) Ukuzuza inkxaso yamaDlagusha acha -sene nenkqubela phambiki.

(ii) Ukudala oonongogwana namabali ezoyikiso ukuze abantu bakhangeke ezi zinto bangawuboni umonaka-lo odalwa lualu-calulo(uPhathiwa-)kweli lizwe.

(iii) Ukuzuza isizathu sokubangisa yo -nke amibutho echasene noRulumente phantsi komhlaba wokuba kugqo -gqo ebebushekelusenziwa kufunyenwe "Iimpawu zemvukelwano-mbuso" ezingenaku papashwa kamsinyane.

(iv) Ukuyikisa abachasene noRulumente. Ingqungquthela iyamvala uRulumente ukuba abantu abantsundu namahla-kani abo abanakulahlekiswa zezi zenzo kwaye kungekho nto enokubapha-mbukisa kwiDaba elilungileyo lokukhulula umZantsi Afrika kumakha-mandela ocalulo asisilingo kweli xesha lethu.

(3) Le Ngqungquthela iyalela lonke ulutsha lomnt'Ontsondu ukuba lungene kumhlambi wezidela-kufa (Freedom Volunteers) ukuze intshu -kumo yeNkululeko ibenokugcina ngenxa yabaququzeli abazinikela ngesisa nangomoya omhle ukuba babe lidini lokusetyenziswa eDabini leNkululeko.

(4) Le Ngqungquthela ivigwalasela ngeliso elitsolo into u Rulumente azimisela ukuyenza kumakhosikazi esizwe ngokuwaphathisa amapasi ukugalela kunyaka ozayo ka 1956.
