I sent quite a good collection of books, and a few records with the last parcel. These were all donated. I press the committee from time to time to find suitable material.

Does a telegram received and replied to, not affect Mr. Sobukwe's weekly quota of letters? If not, then I agree that I should check on whether he is receiving these supplies in this way.
