Accounts and remittances from the Provinces have not been rendered and there is no information whatsoever of our standing, valency and credit.

An appeal is hereby made to you to help correct this state of things by immediately drawing up a full statement and report of the affairs of Congress in your Province and submitting same to the central office.

As you are aware the Executive should meet a month to make final preparations for the Conference December. But in our present position of financial embarrassment and general chaos of our affairs this ve. necessary step will be impossible.
