CONFERENCE WITH BANTU AUTHORS.

The Literature Commission appointed by an inter-church conference on Christian literature for the Bantu of Southern Africa which was held in Johannesburg in 1956 has decided to convene a further conference, this time with the Bantu authors of Southern Africa.

The conference will be held in Pretoria from Tuendayafternoon, 7th July, till Thursday-afternoon, 9th July. A list of the papers which will be read and the names of the persons who will read them is enclosed for your information.

Some 70 Bantu authors and some 10 to 15 European authors who write in the Bantu Inngusges will attend the conference. In addition, some 50 representatives of the churches, mission and conmercial presses and of the S.A. universities are expected to attend.

The Planning Committee extends a cordial invitation to your University to send an observer to this mnference. Observers will be allowed to participate in the discussions and the Committee hopes that these persons, especially if they are selected from the teaching staffs of the Departments of Bentu Lenguages, will have a very real contribution to make to the conference.
