- 6) A copy of an article on my tour that I wrote for At Ease. You can pass this on to ECC Focus in Joberg in case they want to <sup>use</sup> it. It was very rushed and a bit shabby, I'm afraid.

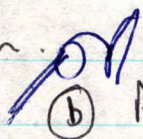


