4. A Partial Eclipse of the *Moon* on July 15/16th, visible in Great Britain.

5. An Annular Eclipse of the *Sun* on December 25th, invisible in Great Britain.

PUBLIC HOLIDAYS, 1954

UNION OF SOUTH AFRICA.—The Public Holidays Amendment Bill, 1951, which was approved by Parliament on 21st February, 1952, and came into operation on 1st April of that year, fixed the following Statutory Holidays to be observed within the Union:—New Year's Day, Van Riebeeck Day (April 6th), Good Friday, Easter Monday, Ascension Day, Union Day (May 31st), Queen's Birthday (2nd Monday in July), Settlers' Day (1st Monday in September), Kruger Day (October 10th), Day of the Covenant (December 16th), Christmas Day and Boxing Day.

The Act provides that when any of these days falls on a Sunday, the following Monday will be kept as the holiday; when Boxing Day falls on a Monday, the Tuesday next following will be a holiday; and when Van Riebeeck Day falls on Good Friday, Easter Day or Easter Monday, the Saturday immediately following Good Friday will be a public holiday.

OBSERVANCES IN 1954.—New Year's Day, January 1st; Van Riebeeck Day, April 6th; Good Friday, April 16th; Easter Monday, April 19th; Ascension Day, May 27th; Union Day, May 31st; Queen's Birthday, July 12th; Settlers' Day, September 6th; Kruger Day, October 11th; Day of Covenant, December 16th; Christmas Day, December 25th; Boxing Day, December 27th.

PUBLIC HOLIDAYS, 1954—*Cont.*

In the HIGH COMMISSION TERRITORIES the Queen's Birthday is observed on a day fixed annually and notified in the *Gazette*, other wise the holidays are the same as in the Union, with the following exceptions :

BASUTOLAND.—Union Day and Day of the Covenant are *not* observed but Moshesh's Day, 12th March, is a Public Holiday.

BECHUANALAND PROTECTORATE.—Union Day and Day of the Covenant are *not* observed but Whit Monday, (June 7th) is a Public Holiday.

SWAZILAND.—Ascension Day and Union Day are *not* observed but Dingaan's Day (16th Dec.) is a Public Holiday.

RHODESIA. — New Year's Day, January 1st; Good Friday, April 16th; Holy Saturday, April 17th (*Southern Rhodesia*); Easter Monday, April 19th; Empire Day, May 24th; Whit Monday, June 7th; Queen's Birthday as decreed; Cecil Rhodes' Day and Founder's Day, July 12th and 13th (*Southern Rhodesia*); August 2nd (*Northern Rhodesia*); Occupation Day, September 13th; Christmas Day and Boxing Day December 25th and 27th.
