PROPOSED ACTIVITIES

MOBILIZATION DAY: Health Sermons, talks, popular mass meetings in churches and halls, outline programs, good speakers, and music.

HOME HEALTH DAY: Home clean-up; parents meetings, separate meetings for mothers and fathers, proper sex education, provision for annual health examination.

COMMUNITY SANITATION DAY: Activities for sanitary needs and improvements-- water, food and milk supply, waste disposal, safe well, sanitary privies.

SPECIAL CAMPAIGN DAY: Survey of health needs and concentration on one or more practical objectives, contact Health Department.

ADULT HEALTH DAY: Health talk to Men's and Women's organizations, Encourage Home Health. Emphasis on annual Health Examination.

SCHOOL HEALTH DAY: Invite parents, Health essays, songs, games, plays, parades, pageants, Health Examination of school and pre-school children, School clean up, Organizing Health Clubs.

GENERAL CLEAN-UP DAY: Cooperative large-scale activities, inspect community, campaign results, collect data and take pictures for reports and news articles. Completion of all unfinished activities

REPORT AND FOLLOW-UP DAY: Enthusiastic meeting for report, good talks, music, experiences, effects of permanent organization. Broadcast (Radio).

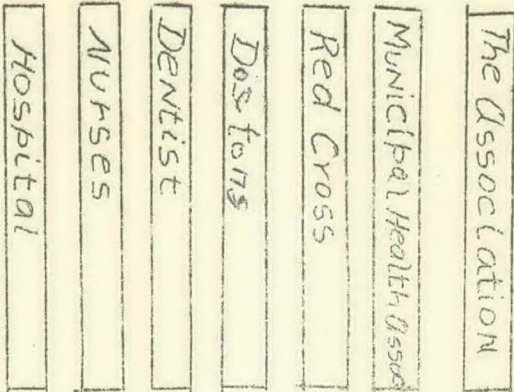
A Grand Motto:

D. Committee on Finance

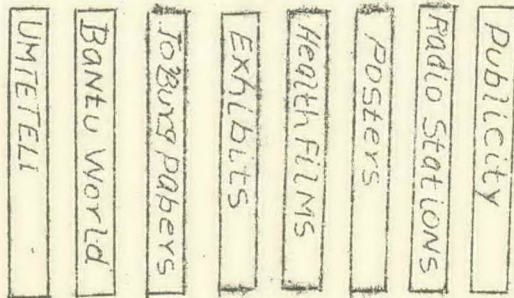
To raise funds for speakers, postage, advertising, and other supplies.

To secure teamwork among social agencies and other interested groups

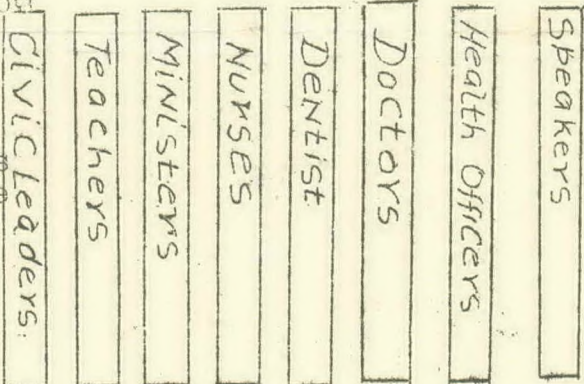
F. Committee on News papers

To secure interest and services of news papers. Most valuable stories of progress of all committees.



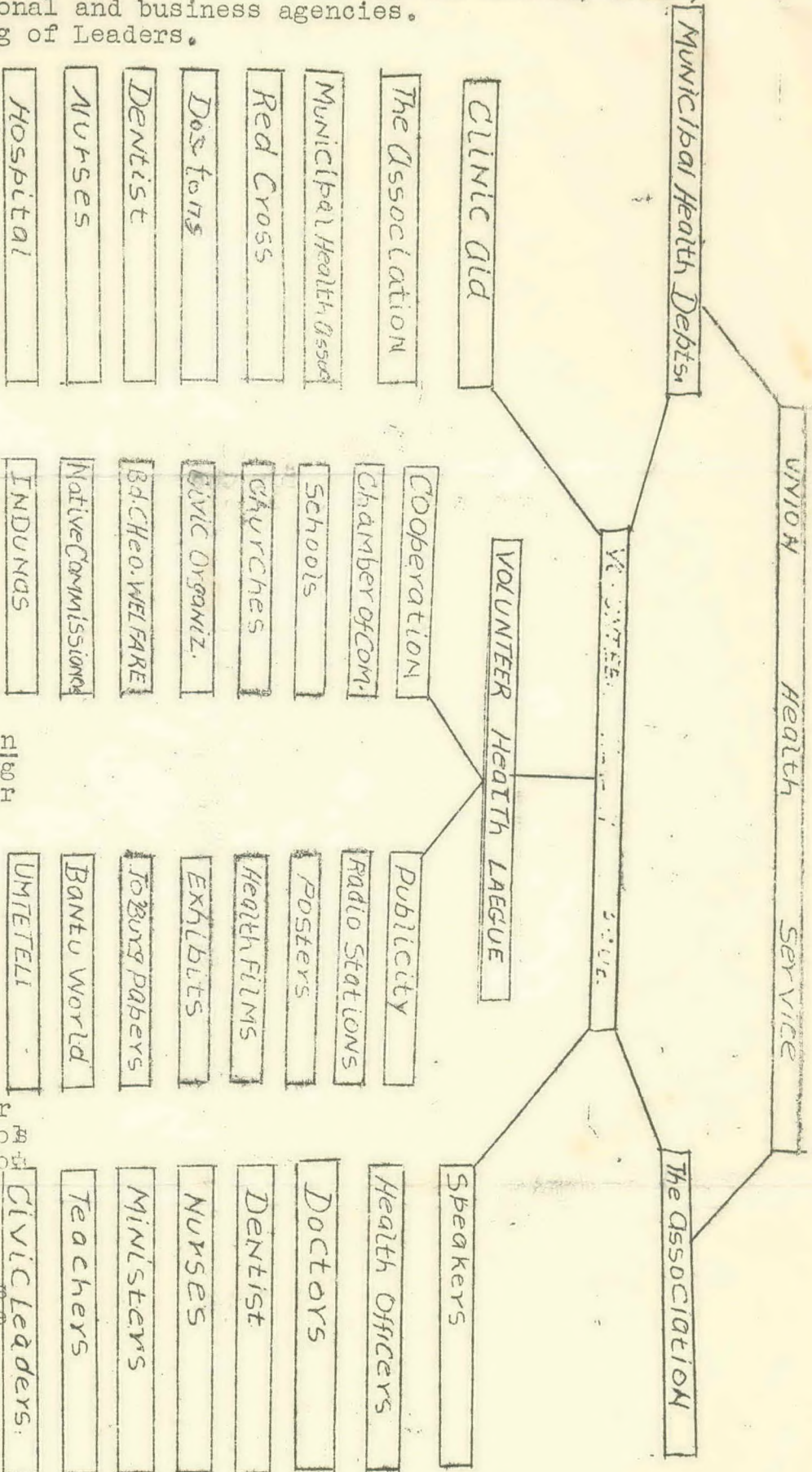
G. Committee on Speakers
