
TRANSVAALJUNIOR CRICKET BOARD

Rules of Play

- 1. A team shall comprise of 15 players, 1 Manager and 1 Umpire.
- 2. All teams shall be registered with the Convenor half an hour before play on the first day.
- 3. The computation date shall be 1st November 1971 i.e. not over 16 on the 1st November 1987. Proof of age should have been submitted with the registration form when player was registered for the club.
- 4. The participating teams shall be divided in sections.

5. Hours of Play:

Play shall commence punctually at 9.30 a.m. each day and end at 6.30 p.m. or earlier if an outright decision has been reached. There shall be a lunch interval of 45 minutes and a Tea Interval of 15 minutes.

Drink breaks may be taken midway between each session.

6. Points

Win by innings/default 12 points. Win on double innings 10 points. Tie on double innings 5 points each. Tie on first innings (match incomplete) 2 points.

Win on first innings (match incomplete) 4 points.

7. Bonus Points

Batting and bowling bonus points shall be scored in the first innings only i.e. within 55 overs of six balls each. There will be compulsory declaration in the first innings after the batting side has reached 55 overs.

1 Batting Point shall be scored on reaching 100 runs and 1 point for every run thereafter.

1 Bowling Point shall be scored on every uneven wicket i.e. on 1, 3, 5, 7, 9.

8. Overs

The over shall consist of six (6) balls. A new ball shall be used for each match. A second new ball may be used at the commencement of the second innings. Teams must maintain an over rate of 16 overs to the hour. A minimum of 20 overs shall be bowled in the last hour of play of each match.

9. Winners of the "Week":

- (a) Shall be the team with the most points.
- (b) In the case of a tie, the team with the most outright wins.
- (c) If there is still a tie, the team which has scored the most runs per wicket.
- If funds allow it certain clubs may be assisted with their travel costs. The Junior Board will provide balls, lunches and teas.
- 11. All matches shall be played on a league basis under the normal I.C.C. rules, save for the rules set out above.
