Jodac, COSG, NEUSA, W.A.P., Black Sash, OASSSA, PFP Youth, (NUSAS), (YCS).

Reasons for resuscitating the Front:

1. Because it broadens our support and image, which is something we often assert (sometimes as a stumbling-block) and which we need to bring into practice again, i.e. we are "officially" a front but need to make it a reality again.
2. Affiliates can work on the campaign in the context of their own work. (our public media exposure has been reduced, this would broaden it).
3. If there was a "final clampdown" - affiliates could continue the work.
4. The broadness of an active front should offer us some protection.

Contact with affiliates:

- meetings with execs, co-ordinating structures
- chair or nat. rep to address gen. meetings of affiliates
- present a written proposal for affiliate involvement

Participation of affiliates:

- drawing them into our activities
- participating in decision-making:
 - x normally at general bodies
 - otherwise at x co-ordinators' gp?
 - or x affiliate reps gp?
- 2nd suggestion more feasible, otherwise co-ord gp becomes mini-GB

Regular frontal contact:

- ECC focus to affils.
- affiliate newsletter
- Front Portfolio in liason with Contact gp maintaining reg gp + facilitating

affiliate participation

Membership drive:

- Suggest: affil. to pay affiliate fee (e.g. R100 or whatever)
- * members to be regarded as assoc. members - i.e. we get access to mailing list
 - * affiliate also has reps who have say in decisions

- Suggestions for new affiliates:
- Jews for Social Justice (JSJ)
 - People Opposed to Women's Abuse (POWA)
 - CASA (?)

SFF + Front

- make contact with potential affiliates
- work alongside existing affiliates => redeveloping our mutual links
- discuss ECC's possible affiliation to SFF with all our affiliates
