No mass. Chaplain rested. Slept the night in the tent. Mr. Johnson from Teppe arrived 1.45. Solemn Vespers 5 p.m. Solemn Eucharist 6 p.m. Mr. Marshall arrived to work 10.45. Mr. Johnson gave Magic lantern lecture 7.30. went on till nearly 9.30.

21st

F. of S. Thomas.

Sung mass 7.45. S.H. B.S. went in to Pretoria 8.24. did shopping till 2.35. S.G. went to see Alice who was a little better. S.H. went to the school. Mr. Johnson left by 11.9. train. Comfort came out by 2.35. to make her confession. returned 7.12. S.G. arrived 8.5. for the Retreat. S.H. went up to nursery after supper to see Katy Clement. who was very bad.

1909

22nd

Mass 7.30. Sisters in Retreat. Chaplain gave his addresses. S.A. & S.F.C. out of Retreat. S. Alice came from the school for Retreat. Mr. Jennings & her baby arrived by 7.12 train

23rd

Mass 6.45. S. Alice & S. A.C. returned to Pretoria by 8.24 train. Chaplain went in to Pretoria. Matron Annie & Matron Alice also went in. returned by 10.45.

Hannah Margaret came out in the afternoon to make their Confessions. Sarah came in the evening stayed the night. Nancy left Mr. Hopley's came to spend the night. also made her Confession. S.H. went in by 9.45 p.m. to Hospital to see Alice. returned by goods train getting back 1.30.

24th

Christmas Eve

Mass 6.45. S.A. went in to see Alice 8.24. Matron Lily Allen went in to shop. Sarah & Nancy left. Katharine, Adelina & Rose came out by 2.35 train Mr. Jennings very troublesome. Reposed to stop ^{pottery, ribbon & process on} left with her baby went to Sanatorium. S.H. went with S.S. to Hospital by late train 9.45. to see Alice who was very bad. dying. She was not conscious. Stayed with her till 11.30. Caught the goods train back. which did not get back till 2.30.

25th

Christmas Day

Mass 7.30. 32 Communicants. Sunj Mass 3 Van der Byls & 2 Taylors came. four communicants made their first Communion. Matron 11 a.m. All Taylor family came. Baby's tea

Christmas Tree at 3.30. Three Little Taylor
came with their nurse. Evening at 6 p.m.
Dinner after in Dining Hall. all together
Chaplain also came. After dinner Christmas
Tree with presents for all. Then carols
& bed.

26th F. of S. Stephen.

Mass 7.30. (Sung). Matins 10.45. Carol singing
round the crèche instead of practice.
Evening Sermon 6.15. Margaret came out
for the afternoon

27th F. of S. John.

Mass 7.30. (Sung) pouring wet day.
Expected Mr. St. Richardson but it was
too wet. dressed the Christmas Tree in
case the Horderns sh^d come in the aft^r.
but they did not come. Cleared up
in the afternoon. Sisters all had tea
together.

28th F. of Holy Innocents.

Mass 7. a.m. Katherine left by 8.24 train
Adeline went in to town with her.
returned 10.45. S.H. went up to tea with
the babes. Clement was received into
the Church at evening. Con nursing.

29th No Mass. Chaplain very tired. rested in
the tent. Chaplain went in to Pretoria.
S^r Emma Keith & S^r Isabel came from Bloemfontein
for a rest. arrived 9.45 p.m.

30th No Mass. Chaplain in Pretoria. He came out 10.45 train. Girls had tea entertainment acting etc in the evening.

31st Mass 7.0 a.m. S.H. went in to Pretoria to do shopping. Change Lampiti. Reports read. Chaplain gave address.

January 1st 1910.

1st 2^d of Circumcision
Sung Mass 6.45. S.H. went in to Pretoria 8.24 train to go see Supervisor. Adeline left to go to her new place. S.H. returned 1.30. Girls left off work 2.0 p.m. had tea in the garden with Sisters. S.H. went off by 7.12 train to stay at D.S.G. till Monday. Miss Oslar staying at Sunaloteni asked to be allowed to come to evening Mass. Margaret ^{left her place} came having

2nd 3rd Sunday after Christmas
Sung Mass 7.30. Same as usual.

3rd Mass 7.30 a.m. S.H. returned 10.45. Thought Baby Ethel out with her to stay at the Mission.

4th Mass 7.0. S.G. went to D.S.G. 8.24. Returned 2.35. Bringing Susie out with her to stay at the Mission. Hannah came to stay for a week.

5th Mass 7.0 a.m. S.H. with S.P.C. took the bus to Bluffton. Sisters in the mule cart to Olifantsfontein to see the Potteries. Started 1.30 never got back till 6.30. Chaplain heard Sisters' Confessions - solemn evening. Comfort came having left her place.

6th7. of the Epiphany

Mass 7.0. a.m. 11.30 all started off for a picnic. with donkey cart Peggy & nurse cart & by train - Chaplain left alone at the House - He joined us for tea - Matilda came with a note wanting to be taken back - S.H. decided to let her work up at the nursery -

7th

No mass - Chaplain rested. S.H. took Kate & Florence in to see the D^r Matilda also went to get her bot. Florence fell out of the Donkey cart & bruised her arm badly - After seeing the D^r went to the school that was there. Caught the 5.40 train back - S.H.C went in to the school to stay.

8th

Mass 7.0 - Capt Dore came out to do accounts 3.0^o Matilda & by made her confession. S.H.C. Hannah went to Johannesburg for the day.

9th1st Sunday after Epiphany.

Sung Mass 7.50 a.m. Katherine of Gertrude & Adeline came to tea. Hannah, Margaret & Comfort admitted to Guild of Perseverance -

10th

Mass. 7.0. a.m. Mary Evans came out with Walter to spend the day. Chaplain left by 3.0^o train for Johannesburg to take Retreat for Resurrection Fathers. Miss Wilmut came out from G.W.C.A. Pretoria. to see the House -

- 11th No mass. S.H. went up to the laundry with S. Emma Keitt. Hannah Margaret took the big babies out for a drive. Mr. Marshall had afternoon off spent it in the tent. Maria Collyer was brought by a friend & stayed in the house. Dr. Davies came sent out by magistrate to examine Matilda as to whether she was a fit case for lunatic asylum - decided no!
- 12th Mr. Rowan rode over from the Heights to say mass 7.45. S.S.M. took S. Emma Keitt & S. Isabel in to Pretoria. S.H. went to Pretoria hotel to speak to C.W.S. about the work. Mr. Wood called in the afternoon to see Gertrude. Mr. Barlow called to see Ralt. S.H. stayed in Pretoria at the school. Lilia arrived for a few days rest.
- 13th No mass. S.H. in Retreat at Pretoria.
- 14th No mass. S.G. went in Pretoria by 8.24 train to go to the D. S.G. stayed on at the school to do the housekeeping. S.H. returned by 10.45 train with Superior who went to stay with the Bishop. Chaplain came back by 12.20 train from Johannesburg. Margaret went in to the school as temporary cook. S.H. went in by 1.45. to catch C.S. Lilia who with S. Alice & S. Emily, houses were on their way back from their holiday. S.H. came back by 2.35 train. Lilia & Lilia admitted members of Guild.

15th Mass 7 a.m. Gals settled till breakfast.
S.J.C. returned from the school. S.A.C.
went back to the school by 1.45 train.
3 Ladies called to see over the House -
Dulce people. S.S.M. took Sr. Keelt 18th Mabel
for a walk. Sr. M. went to bed before supper.
S.H. went up to the nursery after dinner.

16th 2nd Sunday after Epiphany.

sung Mass 7.30. Matins & Sermon 10.45. Katherina
& Gertrude came out by 10.45 train. returned to
Pretoria 6.45 train. S.H. went by 6.45 train to
Pretoria to sleep the night. Chaplain also
went in by 6.45 train to preach at the Cathedral
till the night. to say Mass at the school
next morning.

17th No Mass. S.H. in Pretoria all day also Chaplain.
Bishop went to the school. Matted to all the
Sisters. S.H. returned by 5.40 train also
Chaplain.

18th Mass 7 a.m. Grace Davenport came down
to the House to live her afternoon off.
W. Marsh came down to the House to
sleep. S.H. went up to the nursery in
the afternoon.

Chaplain went in to Pretoria 1.45. S.A.

- 3rd No mass 7 am - Sister Stella Mand went in to the Dentist 8:25. returned 10:45. Chaplain returned by same train. Matron Annie Llanthan Alice went in to Pretoria 1:45 & returned 5:45. Miss Staples brought Mr. Cuthbert to see S. N. S. N. went to see Mr. Hopley. S. Annette returned home from Johannesburg by the 1:45. M. Brockman came to see the Chaplain.

seen off at the station by S. E. W. S. A. S. F. C. - Matron
Annie, Matron Alice, Matron Ellen - Margaret. Hannah,
Nancy - Adeline went into Pretoria with her, signed with Katharine.
Hannah stayed to make her Confession - Even song 6.
S. S. M. went to Pretoria 7.12, Hannah went with her.
S. S. M. stayed the night to see S. H. dismissed.
- 14th No mass. S. E. W. S. A. S. F. C. went down to the station
to see S. Hilda pass through - the train stopped &
the sisters were able to speak to Sister for a few
minutes - S. Hilda had been dismissed by the Vicar who
said mass for the Sisters in the Chapel of the Nativity
at 6. am. S. S. M. returned from Pretoria by 10.45
train with Adeline. Superior came out, to take charge
at 3 & brought S. W. K. with her. Maria went to the Nursery to live.
- 15th Superior went into Pretoria at 1.45 - returned at 6.15.
Margaret came from Johannesburg 7.15. Mrs. Marsh slept in St. Joseph.
16. No mass, Chaplain not well. Superior went to Pretoria
at 7.18. returned at 10.45. Father Fuller came to see the
Chaplain. Mrs. Marsh slept in St. Joseph.
