YOU HAVE THE RIGHT OF APPEAL
If you have been re-clasaified already you have the right of appeal. You may appeal at any time and need not pay any deposit. You must appeal through the Director of Census, Protoria, to a Board set up uhder the Act. If you are not satisfied with the Board's decision you may appeal to the Supreme Court.

Rumours are being spread that the Coloured people must report for classification before esertain date. This is not true. There is no obligation on you to report for questioning. WHAT YOU MUST DO!

1. Tell all your friends these faets about their rights.
2. Don't panic and rush for examination as you are not compelled to do so.
