From about 02.00 hrs. this morning the South African Security Forces raided the homes of the national, regional and branch leaders of the Fan Africanist Congress (PAC) of Azania/South Africa. Over 50 members have been arrested, including the National Organiser and member of the Negotiating Forum, Mr Maxwell Neundzivhanani, as well as National Executive Council members. Property from the national headqurters, regional and branch offices was confiscated.

The PAC calls upon the international community to condemn unreservedly this flagrant violation of the political freedom and human rights by a racist regime that has long practised the odious and repressive apartheid policies of racial segregation.

The PAC further calls upon those who are engaged in the Negotiating Forum with the de Klerk regime to withdraw from the negotiations until (1) all the arrested PAC members have been released, and (ii) all the confiscated Party property has been restored.
