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STATEMENT.

WITH REGARD TO THE ALL-IN AFRICAN PEOPLE'S CONFIDENCE TO BE PINTERMARITZEURO ON THE 25th AND 26th MARCH, 1961.

As a result of Press Statments and political pronouncements by organisations, both African and non-African, and also by political leaders in the country, emanating from the All-African Leaders Conference held at Orlando in Desember, 1960, and the coming All-in African People's Conference to be held in Pietermaritsburg on the 25th and 26th of March this year, it has become increasingly necessary for us as African Matienaltists and as those who were invited and attended to reiterate the circumstances and reasons for our participation in the last Conference. Those of us who were invited and did attend hade it abundantly clear to the sponsors and to Conference that we would only attend the Conference only if non-Afgicing were explained from it and further that we would not be a party to any discussion relating to the calling of a multi-rectal easierence whatsoever. That explains why at the beginning of the Conference when two non-African members of the Liberal Party gateerashed the Conferences, Mesere Molefi, Moleta and Mbelu threatened to leave the Conference unless these men were told to leave.

We genuinely sought, as we now do, a genuine basis of unity among the African people into a compact whole ready for an assault against white domination. We still stand firm by these conditions.

Be that as it may, with various Press statements and pronouncements In the second inbreasingly apparent to us that the main purpose of the Pieternaritaburg Conference this month has shifted from "To seek unity enong the African people" to one of preparing the ground for a multi-racial Convention and to prepare a "new constitution for " South Africa."

Our position then becomes alear. We intend therefore by this means to place on record our ettitude which we make bold to say is the inescapable standpoint of all gemine African Mationalists in the

country. It is essential that the true objectives of the Africans be elearly grasped and the African leaders should exercise exceptional vigilance in guarding, controlling and advancing the hiberatory struggle.

The Africana must guard against the infiltration of ideas that are selected to confuse and make obscure the goal towards which we are an ideal strifing. It is the duty of the African leaders to correct any visible diversionary tendency. It is the leaders duty to see that the African masses keep strictly within the confines of activity inspired by and rooted on the ideology of African Mationalism. The programmes that flow out must be implemented accurately to their mathematical details.

The leaders are the political guardians of the African masses in their struggles towards the realisation of freedom and independent and as such must unequivocably refuse to be used as tools by individuals or example the struggles and political and they should reject infiltrations of ideologies and political which serve to mislend us in favour of the East, West or Middle East.

If we understand this stand-point, the only basis of ec-operation that is acceptable and practicable in the struggle is UNITY IN POSITIVE ACTION, on the basis of African Maticallian. The attention of the African masses throughtout Africa te-day should be focussed on all the arrested, detained and imprisioned leaders.

Desetting South Africa. We ALGER our achieve Freedom and Independence

Ind Iny suggestion that we expect ALGER do so is a frontal attack against
our stand-point and gammine African Nationalism. The Africans have not

lost faith in themselves. We, the indeginous African unjority, pursuing
a Pan-Africani programme, — only We can provide a lasting
soluting to the problems not only of the so-called South Africa but
of the Continent. We therefore earnet be a party to any conference
based on preparation for a futile and barren indaba.
