AMENDMENT.

"that all the words after 'that' where it appears in the recommendation for the first time, be deleted and that the words be substituted by the words 'the estimates of income and expenditure on the revenue and capital accounts in respect of the year 1967/68, as submitted, be referred back to the Management Committee for reconsideration, especially to ensure that

- (1) the account of the Bantu Branch is balanced, i.e. that no shortage be carried over to the Rate Fund;
- (2) the Council will gain the maximum benefit from the vote of the Electricity Department;
- (3) the basis of the valuation of property shall be proportionate;
- (4) the rate tariff on land valuations is reduced to adjust it to the amended estimates."
