

## Flat signs

8. (1) (a) Flat signs shall not exceed in aggregate area 40 square metres or one-quarter of the overall area of the main wall to which they are affixed or on which they are painted, whichever of these figures is the lesser.

(b) Notwithstanding the provisions of paragraphs (a), flat signs painted on a main wall of a factory building in an industrial zone may have an aggregate area not exceeding half the overall area of such wall, provided such aggregate area does not exceed 40 square metres.

(2) No flat sign shall extend above the top of such main wall or beyond either end of such main wall.

## Projecting signs

9. (1) No part of any projecting sign shall project in front of the main wall to which such sign is affixed to greater extent than -

(i) 1,5 m in the case of a sign which has a clear height of not less than 7,5 m; or

(ii) 1 m in the case of any other sign;

provided, however, that where a sign has a clear height of less than 7,5 m -

(a) any portion of such sign which is not more than 0,6 m in depth may project as aforesaid to an extent of more than 1 m but not more than 1,5 m, provided that there shall be a clear vertical distance of not less than 3,6 m between any two successive portions, if any, so projecting; and

(b) any such sign which is not more than 0,6 m in depth may project as aforesaid to an extent of more than 1 m but not more than 1,5 m, provided that there shall be a clear vertical distance of not less than 3,6 m between any two such signs, if any, which are in the same vertical plane.

(2) No projecting sign shall extend above the top of the main wall to which it is affixed.

(3) The depth of a projecting sign shall not exceed one-and-a-quarter times the clear height of such sign.

(4) A projecting sign shall not exceed 600 mm in thickness.

## Plat advertensies

8. (1) (a) Die hele oppervlakte wat deur die plat advertensies beslaan mag word, mag hoogstens 40 m<sup>2</sup>, of een-kwart van die totale oppervlakte van die hoofmuur waaraan hulle bevestig of waarop hulle geverf is, watter oppervlakte ook al die kleinste is.

(b) Ondanks die bepalings van paragraaf (a), kan plat advertensies wat op 'n hoofmuur van 'n fabrieksgebou in 'n nywerheidsone geverf is, 'n totale oppervlakte van hoogstens die helfte van die totale oppervlakte van sodanige muur beslaan, mits sodanige totale oppervlakte nie 40 m<sup>2</sup> oorskry nie.

(2) Geen plat advertensie mag bokant sodanige hoofmuur of verby enige ent daarvan uitsteek nie.

## Advertensies wat uitsteek

9. (1) Geen deel van enige advertensie wat uitsteek mag voor die hoofmuur waaraan sodanige advertensie bevestig is, verder uitsteek nie as -

(i) 1,5 m in die geval van 'n advertensie wat 'n onbelemmerde hoogte van minstens 7,5 m het; of

(ii) 1 m in die geval van enige ander advertensie;

met dien verstande egter dat waar 'n advertensie 'n onbelemmerde hoogte van minder as 7,5 m het -

(a) enige deel van sodanige advertensie wat nie meer as 0,6 m, in diepte is nie, meer as 1 m maar nie meer as 1,5 m nie kan uitsteek soos vermeld; met dien verstande dat daar 'n onbelemmerde vertikale afstand van minstens 3,6 m moet wees tussen enige twee sodanige advertensies, indien daar enige is, wat aldus uitsteek; en

(b) enige sodanige advertensie wat hoogstens 0,6 m in diepte is nie, meer as 1 m, maar nie meer as 1,5 m nie, kan uitsteek soos vermeld; met dien verstande dat daar 'n onbelemmerde vertikale afstand van minstens 3,6 m moet wees tussen enige twee sodanige advertensies, indien daar enige is, wat in dieselfde vertikale vlak is.

(2) Geen advertensie wat uitsteek, mag bokant die bopunt van die hoofmuur waaraan dit bevestig is, uitsteek nie.

(3) Die diepte van 'n advertensie wat uitsteek, mag nie een-en-'n-kwart maal die onbelemmerde hoogte van sodanige advertensie oorskry nie.

(4) 'n Advertensie wat uitsteek, mag nie 'n dikte van meer as 600 mm hê nie.

## Sky-signs

10. (1) The depth of a sky-sign shall not exceed one-sixth of the clear height of such sky-sign.

(2) The length of a sky-sign shall not exceed -

(i) 14 m, if the depth of such sky-sign does not exceed 4,50 m, or

(ii) 18m, if the depth of such sky-sign exceeds 4,50 m.

(3) No horizontal dimension of that portion of the structure which supports a sky-sign and which is at a height of more than one-tenth of the depth of such sky-sign above the lowest edge of such sky-sign shall, when measured at right angles to the plane of the face of such sky-sign, exceed one-fifteenth of the depth of such sky-sign.

(4) No sky-sign shall, when viewed in plan, extend -

(i) In front of the main wall immediately below it in any case in which the roof over which it is affixed does not extend beyond such main wall, or,

(ii) beyond the edge of the roof over which it is affixed in any other case.

(5) Every sky-sign shall be as near to the roof over which it is affixed as the configuration of the building concerned or of the sky-sign will permit.

(6) The provisions of Section 6 (1) and (2) shall not apply to any sky-sign affixed to a building located in the area defined in Schedule 3 to this by-law unless such building is also located in an area of special control defined in Schedule 2 to this by-law.

## Roof signs

10A (1) Roof signs may be painted on the roofs of shops, business premises and industrial buildings only.

(2) The subject matter of a roof sign shall be limited to the name of the premises on which it is painted, the name of the occupier of such premises and the names of articles manufactured or sold therein.

(3) The aggregate area of all roof sign painted on any one building shall not exceed 40 m<sup>2</sup>.

## Signs on verandahs and balconies

11. (1) The following signs and no others may be affixed to or painted on verandahs and balconies:-

## Lugadvertensies

10. (1) Die diepte van 'n lugadvertensie mag nie een-sesde van die onbelemmerde hoogte van sodanige lugadvertensie te bowe gaan nie.

(2) Die lengte van 'n lugadvertensie mag nie meer wees nie as -

(i) 14 m indien die diepte van sodanige lugadvertensie nie 450 m te bowe gaan nie, of

(ii) 18 m indien die diepte van sodanige lugadvertensie 4,50 m te bowe gaan nie.

(3) Geen horisontale afmeting van die deel van die struktuur wat 'n lugadvertensie steun en wat op 'n hoogte van meer as een-tiende van die diepte van sodanige lugadvertensie is, mag, wanneer reghoekig op die vlak van die voorvlak van sodanige lugadvertensie gemeet, een-vyftiende van die diepte van sodanige lugadvertensie te bowe gaan nie.

(4) Geen lugadvertensie, wanneer in plattegrond beskou, mag -

(i) voor die hoofmuur onmiddellik daaronder uitsteek in geval waar die dak waaroor dit bevestig is, nie verby sodanige hoofmuur uitsteek nie, of,

(ii) in enige ander geval verby die kant van die dak waaroor dit bevestig is, uitsteek nie.

(5) Elke lugadvertensie moet so na wees aan die dak waaroor dit bevestig word as wat die vorm van die betrokke gebou of van die lugadvertensie toelaat.

(6) Die bepalings van artikel 6 (1) en (2) is nie van toepassing op enige lugadvertensie bevestig aan 'n gebou geleë in die gebied omskrywe in Bylae 3 van hierdie verordening nie, tensy sodanige gebou ook geleë is in 'n gebied van spesiale beheer omskrywe in Bylae 2 van hierdie verordening.

## Dakadvertensies

10A (1) Dakadvertensies kan alleen op die dakke van winkels, sakepersele en nywerheidsgeboue geverf word.

(2) Die inhoud van 'n dakadvertensie word beperk tot die naam van die perseel waarop dit geverf is, die naam van die okkupeerder van sodanige perseel en die name van die artikels wat daarin vervaardig of verkoop word.

(3) Die totale oppervlakte van alle dakadvertensies wat op enige enkele gebou geverf is, mag hoogstens 40 m<sup>2</sup> wees.

## Advertensies op verandas en balkonne

11. (1) Die volgende advertensies en geen ander nie mag bevestig word aan of geverf word op verandas en balkonne:-

(1) Signs affixed flat on to or painted on a parapet wall, balustrade or railing of a verandah or a balcony.

(11) Signs affixed flat on to or painted on a beam or fascia of a verandah or a balcony.

(111) Signs suspended below the roof of a verandah or the floor of a balcony.

(2) No sign affixed to a parapet wall, balustrade or railing of a verandah or a balcony shall exceed 1 m in depth, or project above or below or beyond either end of such parapet wall, balustrade or railing, or project more than 250 mm in front of such parapet wall, balustrade or railing.

(3) No sign affixed to a beam or fascia of a verandah or balcony shall exceed 600 mm in depth, or project above or below or beyond either end of such beam or fascia, or project more than 250 mm in front of such beam or fascia. Where any such sign is affixed to a beam which is at right angles to the building line and which is below the roof of a verandah or the floor of a balcony, such sign shall not exceed 1,8 m in length.

(4) No sign suspended below the roof of a verandah or the floor of a balcony shall exceed 1,8 m in length or 600 mm in depth. Every such sign shall be at right angles to the building line.

(5) Notwithstanding the foregoing, it shall be permissible to erect signs on the roof of a verandah or balcony, subject to the following conditions:-

(1) Every such sign shall be composed of a single line of free-standing, individual, cut-out silhouette letters without visible bracing or other visible means of support.

(11) Every such sign shall lie either in the vertical plane passing through the front edge of such roof (being an edge parallel to the kerb line) or in a vertical plane passing through a side edge of such roof (being an edge at right angles to the kerb line); provided that such signs shall not be erected along more than two edges of such roof; provided further that any such sign which is erected along a side edge of such roof shall be limited to not more than 12 letters.

(111) The subject matter of such signs shall be limited to that referred to in paragraphs (a), (b) and (c) of sub-section (1) of Section 6; provided that it shall be permissible in addition to include subject matter referred to in paragraph (d) thereof if such additional subject matter is limited to not more than 12 letters on any one roof.

(1) Advertensies wat plat bevestig is aan of geverf is op 'n borswering, balustrade or railing van 'n veranda of 'n balkon.

(11) Advertensies wat plat bevestig is aan of geverf is op 'n balk of fassie van 'n veranda of 'n balkon.

(111) Advertensies wat onderkant die dak van 'n veranda of die vloer van 'n balkon hang.

(2) Geen advertensie wat aan 'n borswering, balustrade of railing van 'n veranda of 'n balkon bevestig is, mag 1 m in diepte te bowe gaan, of bokant of onderkant of verby enige ent van sodanige borswering, balustrade of railing uitsteek, of meer as 250 mm voor sodanige borswering, balustrade of railing uitsteek nie.

(3) Geen advertensie wat aan 'n balk of fassie van 'n veranda of balkon bevestig is, mag 600 mm in diepte te bowe gaan, of bokant of onderkant of verby enige ent van sodanige balk of fassie uitsteek, of meer as 250 mm voor sodanige balk of fassie uitsteek nie. Waar enige sodanige advertensie bevestig is aan 'n balk wat reghoekig op die boulyn en onderkant die dak van 'n veranda of die vloer van 'n balkon is, mag sodanige advertensie hoogstens 1,8 m in lengte wees.

(4) Geen advertensie wat onderkant die dak van 'n veranda of die vloer van 'n balkon hang, mag meer as 1,8 m lank of 600 mm diep wees nie. Elk sodanige advertensie moet reghoekig op die boulyn wees.

(5) Ondanks die bogenoemde, is dit toelaatbaar om advertensies op die dak van 'n veranda of balkon, op te rig, onderworpe aan die volgende voorwaardes:-

(1) Elk sodanige advertensie moet uit 'n enkele reël afsonderlik, alleenstaande, uitgesnyde silhoeëtletters sonder sigbare verspanning of ander sigbare steunmiddels bestaan.

(11) Elk sodanige advertensie moet geplaas word, hetsy in die vertikale vlak wat deur die voorste rand van sodanige dak gaan (synde 'n rand parallel met die straatrandlyn) of in 'n vertikale vlak wat deur 'n kantrand van sodanige dak gaan (synde 'n rand reghoekig met die straatrandlyn); met dien verstande dat sodanige advertensies nie langs meer as twee rande van sodanige dak opgerig mag word nie; voorts met dien verstande dat enige sodanige advertensie wat langs 'n kantrand van sodanige dak opgerig word tot hoogstens 12 letters beperk word.

(111) Die inhoud van sodanige advertensies moet beperk wees tot dié waarna in paragrafe (a), (b) en (c) van subartikel (1) van artikel 6 verwys word; met dien verstande dat dit bowendien toelaatbaar is om inhoud in te sluit waarna in paragraaf (d) daarvan verwys word, indien sodanige bykomstige inhoud tot hoogstens 12 letters op enige enkele dak beperk is.

(iv) The depth of such signs shall not exceed 600 mm.

(v) For the purposes of this sub-section the term "letters" shall include symbols or emblems.

(vi) Provided that in the case of a sign advertising forthcoming or current entertainment erected at a cinema or theatre -

(a) the depth of such sign may exceed 600 mm but shall not exceed 1,5 m, and

(b) such sign may include one picture or illustration not exceeding 5,0 square metres in area.

(6) Notwithstanding the provisions of sub-section (1) of Section 17, it shall be permissible for a sign suspended below the roof of a verandah or the floor of a balcony to be bordered by a running light, provided that such running light border shall be not more than 75 mm in width.

(7) For the purposes of applying sub-section (4) the inner edge of any running light border to a sign referred to in sub-section (6) shall be deemed to be the outer edge of such sign.

Signs over footways and roadways

12. (1) Any sign projecting over a footway forming part of a public street shall be not less than 2,4 m in clear height, provided that a flat sign in the form of a showcase for the display of goods may project not more than 50 mm over such footway if such footway is not less than 1,5 m wide, irrespective of the clear height of such showcase.

(2) Any sign projecting more than 150 mm over any place where persons may walk, if such place is not a footway forming part of a public street, shall be not less than 2,1 m in clear height.

(3) No part of a sign projecting over a footway forming part of a public street shall be nearer than 300 mm to a vertical plane through the kerb line of such footway.

(4) Where a public street has no footway signs may project over the carriageway of such public street, if such signs are not less than 6,0 m in clear height.

(iv) Die diepte van sodanige advertensies mag hoogstens 600 mm wees.

(v) Vir sover dit hierdie subartikel betref, sluit die uitdrukking "letters" simbole of embleme in.

(vi) Met dien verstande dat in die geval van 'n advertensie wat toekomstige of huidige vermaaklikheid adverteer en by 'n bioskoop of teater opgerig word -

(a) die diepte van sodanige advertensie 600 mm kan oorskry, maar 1,5 m nie mag oorskry nie, en

(b) sodanige advertensie een prent of illustrasie kan insluit waarvan die oppervlakte nie 5,0 vierkante metres mag oorskry nie.

(6) Ondanks die bepalings van subartikel (1) van artikel 17, is dit toelaatbaar dat 'n advertensie wat onderkant die dak van 'n veranda of die vloer van 'n balkon hang, van 'n rand bestaande uit 'n lopende lig voorsien kan wees; met dien verstande dat sodanige lopende ligrand hoogstens 75 mm breed mag wees.

(7) Vir die doeleindes van die toepassing van subartikel (4) word die binnerand van enige lopende ligrand van 'n advertensie waarna in subartikel (6) verwys word as die buiterand van sodanige advertensie beskou.

Advertensies oor loopplaat en ryvlakke

12. (1) Enige advertensie wat uitsteek oor 'n loopplaat wat deel van 'n openbare straat uitmaak, moet 'n onbelemmerde hoogte van minstens 2,4 m hê; met dien verstande dat 'n plat advertensie in die vorm van 'n uitstakas vir die vertoning van goedere hoogstens 50 mm bo sodanige loopplaat mag uitsteek indien sodanige loopplaat minstens 1,5 m breed is, ongeag die onbelemmerde hoogte van sodanige uitstakas.

(2) Enige advertensie wat meer as 150 mm uitsteek oor enige plek waar mense kan loop, indien sodanige plek nie 'n loopplaat is wat deel van 'n openbare straat uitmaak nie, moet 'n onbelemmerde hoogte van minstens 2,1 m hê.

(3) Geen deel van 'n advertensie wat uitsteek oor 'n loopplaat wat deel van 'n openbare straat uitmaak, mag nader as 300 mm aan 'n loodregte vlak deur die straatrandlyn van sodanige voetpad wees nie.

(4) Waar 'n openbare straat geen loopplaat het nie, kan advertensies oor die ryvlak van sodanige openbare straat uitsteek as sodanige advertensies 'n onbelemmerde hoogte van minstens 6 m het.

## Certain signs prohibited

13. (1) Notwithstanding anything in this by-law contained, the following types of sign are prohibited:-

(a) Swinging signs, loose portable signs (other than signs designated for the purpose of being carried through the street and signs on portable racks or other articles for containing and displaying goods), aerial signs and other signs not rigidly fixed.

(b) Posters, except:-

(i) any poster referred to in sub-section (2) of Section 3 of this by-law.

(ii) any poster comprising any such sign as is referred to in paragraphs (i), (ii), (iii), (iv), (v), (vi), (vii), (x), (xv), (xvi) or (xvii) of sub-section (2) of Section 22.

(c) Any sign which is so placed as to obstruct, obscure, interfere with, or otherwise to be likely to introduce confusion into, the effective working of any traffic sign or of the harbour.

(2) No person shall exhibit in any place to which the public has access or shall expose to public view any advertisement, placard, poster, engraving, picture, drawing, print or photograph of an indecent, obscene, repulsive, revolting or objectionable character, or of a nature calculated to produce a pernicious or injurious effect on the public or any particular class of persons.

(3) Any person contravening the provisions of sub-section (2) shall be guilty of an offence.

(4) Notwithstanding the provisions of paragraph (a) of sub-section (1) it shall be permissible to display a sign, the whole or any part of which is mechanically or electrically actuated so as to revolve, oscillate or move about or along a fixed line, provided that no such sign or part thereof which is so actuated shall have a clear height of less than 9 m and every such sign shall be of robust and durable construction.

## Signs on walls, fences and hoardings

14. (1) Except as in Section 22 provided, no sign shall be affixed to or painted on a wall (other than a wall of a building), a fence or a hoarding, unless in the opinion of the COUNCIL such wall, fence or hoarding serves primarily to conceal a condition or attribute of the property on which such wall, fence or hoarding is erected, which condition or attribute is unsightly by reason of the use to which such property is lawfully being put, or unless such wall, fence or hoarding is a temporary measure to protect the public in the neighbourhood of building, demolition or similar operations.

## Sekere verbode advertensies

13. (1) Ondanks enige bepalinge in hierdie verordening vervat, word die volgende soorte advertensies verbied:-

(a) Swaal-advertensies, los draagbare advertensies (behalwe advertensies ontwerp vir die doel om deur die strate gedra te word en advertensies op draagbare rame of ander voorwerpe om goedere te bevat en te vertoon), sweefadvertensies en ander advertensies wat nie onbeweeglik bevestig is nie.

(b) Plakkate, uitgesonderd -

(i) enige plakkaat waarna in subartikel (2) van artikel 3 van hierdie verordening verwys word;

(ii) enige plakkaat wat enige advertensie behels waarna in paragraaf (i), (ii), (iii), (iv), (v), (vi), (vii), (x), (xv), (xvi) of (xvii) van subartikel (2) van artikel 22 verwys word.

(c) Enige advertensie wat so geplaas is dat dit die doeltreffende werking van enige verkeerstekens versper, of van die hawe, onduidelik maak, belemmer of andersins moontlike verwarring daarin kan veroorsaak.

(2) Niemand mag enige advertensie, aanplakbiljet, plakkaat, gravure, prent, tekening, afdruk of foto van 'n onbetaamlike, onsedelike, weersinwekkende, walglike of aanstootlike aard of van 'n aard wat 'n skadelike of verderflike invloed op die publiek of 'n bepaalde klas persone kan hê, vertoon op 'n plek waartoe die publiek toegang het of dit blootstel op 'n plek waar die publiek dit kan sien nie.

(3) Iedereen wat die bepalinge van subartikel (2) oortree, is aan 'n misdryf skuldig.

(4) Ondanks die bepalinge van paragraaf (a) van subartikel (1), is dit toelaatbaar om 'n advertensie te vertoon, waarvan die hele of enige deel meganies of elektries in werking gestel word om te draai, te slinger, of op 'n langsame of 'n vaste lyn te beweeg; met dien verstande dat geen sodanige advertensie of deel daarvan wat aldus in werking gestel word, 'n onbelemmerde hoogte van minder as 9 m mag hê nie, en elk sodanige advertensie van stewige en duursame konstruksie moet wees.

## Advertensies aan mure, heininge en skuttinge

14. (1) Behalwe soos by artikel 22 bepaal, mag geen advertensie bevestig word aan of geveer word op 'n muur (behalwe 'n muur van 'n gebou), 'n heining of 'n skutting nie, tensy sodanige muur, heining of skutting na die mening van die RAAD in die eerste plaas daartoe dien om 'n toestand of eienskap van die eiendom waarop sodanige muur, heining of skutting oogerig is, te verberg, waar sodanige toestand of eienskap onooglik is as gevolg van die wettige gebruik van sodanige eiendom, of tensy sodanige muur, heining of skutting 'n tydelike maatregel is om die publiek in die omgewing teen bou- of slopingswerk of dergelike bedrywighede te beskerm.

(2) In granting its approval in terms of Section 3 for the affixing or painting of any such sign, the COUNCIL may grant such approval for a limited period only, and the provisions of Section 6 shall not apply to such sign.

(3) Every such sign affixed or painted in terms of this section shall comply with the following requirements:-

(1) No such sign shall exceed 3 m in depth or 5,5 m in overall height.

(11) Poster signs shall be enclosed within definite panels, which shall be uniform in size and level.

(4) Notwithstanding the provisions of sub-section (1), it shall be permissible to affix a sign to a wall (not being a wall of a building) if such sign is composed of individual, unilluminated cut-out letters or symbols fixed flat on such wall, not projecting more than 50 mm from the face of such wall, or of individual letters, emblems or symbols forming part of the permanent fabric of such wall.

#### Signs on poles and other structures

15. (1) Except as in Section 22 provided, no sign shall be affixed to or painted on a pole or any other structure which is not a building, wall, fence or hoarding unless -

(1) such sign is indispensable for the effectual conduct of the activity in connection with which it is displayed and

(11) either -

(a) It is impracticable to display a sign effectually at the premises concerned except by affixing a sign to or painting a sign on a pole or other structure as aforesaid, or

(b) In the opinion of the COUNCIL a particular sign intended to be affixed to or painted on a pole or other structure as aforesaid would not detract from the amenities of the neighbourhood or depreciate neighbouring property to a greater extent than a sign capable of being displayed at the premises in conformity with any other section of this by-law would do.

(2) Where in the opinion of the COUNCIL serious difficulty is experienced by the public in finding the way to a factory in an industrial zone the COUNCIL may permit the erection of a signboard on a pole on a vacant erf in such zone for purposes of indicating the direction to such factory, subject to the following conditions:-

(2) By die verlening van sy goedkeuring ooreenkomstig artikel 3 vir die bevestiging of verf van enige sodanige advertensie, kan die RAAD sodanige goedkeuring net vir 'n beperkte tydperk verleen, en die bepalings van artikel 6 is nie op sodanige advertensie van toepassing nie.

(3) Elk sodanige advertensie wat ooreenkomstig hierdie artikel bevestig of geverf is, moet aan die volgende vereistes voldoen:-

(1) Geen sodanige advertensie mag 3 m in diepte of 5,5 m in totale hoogte te bowe gaan nie.

(11) Plakkaatadvertensies moet in bepaalde panele wat eenvormig van grotte en vlak moet wees, omsluit wees.

(4) Ondanks die bepalings van subartikel (1), is dit toelaatbaar om 'n advertensie aan 'n muur te bevestig (wat nie 'n muur van 'n gebou is nie) indien sodanige advertensie bestaan uit afsonderlike, onverligte, uitgesnyde letters of simbole wat plat op sodanige muur aangebring is en nie meer as 50 mm van die vlak van sodanige muur uitsteek nie of uit afsonderlike letters, embleme of simbole wat deel van die permanente materiaal van sodanige muur uitmaak.

#### Advertensies aan pale en ander strukture

15. (1) Behalwe soos by artikel 22 bepaal, mag geen advertensie bevestig word aan of geverf word op 'n paal of enige ander struktuur wat nie 'n gebou, muur, heining of skutting is nie, tensy -

(1) sodanige advertensie onontbeerlik is vir die doeltreffende bestuur van die bedrywigheid in verband waarmee dit vertoon word, en

(11) of

(a) dit ondoenlik is om 'n advertensie doeltreffend op die betrokke perseel te vertoon behalwe deur 'n advertensie aan 'n paal of ander struktuur soos voornoem, te bevestig of 'n advertensie daarop te verf, of

(b) volgens die mening van die RAAD, 'n bepaalde advertensie wat bedoel is om aan 'n paal of ander struktuur soos voornoem, bevestig of daarop geverf te word, nie afbreuk sal doen aan die aantreklikheid van die omgewing of die waarde van aangrensende eiendomme in 'n groter mate sal verminder as wat 'n advertensie wat op die perseel vertoon kan word ooreenkomstig enige ander artikel van hierdie verordening, sou doen nie.

(2) Waar, volgens die RAAD se mening, ernstige moeilikheid deur die publiek ondervind word om die weg na 'n fabriek in 'n nywerheidsone te vind, kan die RAAD die oprigting van 'n advertensiebord aan 'n paal op 'n onbeboude erf in sodanige sone toelaat vir die doeleindes van aanduiding van die rigting na sodanige fabriek, onderworpe aan die volgende voorwaardes:-

(1) Not more than one such signboard shall be erected on any one erf; but it shall be permissible to indicate the direction to more than one factory on any such signboard.

(11) The subject matter of the signs on such signboard shall be limited to the names of the factories concerned, the names of their occupiers, and essential directional information; and the lettering employed shall not exceed 100 mm in height.

(3) Where in its opinion this is reasonably required, the COUNCIL may permit the erection of a signboard on a pole on a vacant erf in a township for the purposes of displaying thereon a map showing the street names and erf numbers of such township, together with the name and address of the owner of or agent for such township and the name of the township. Such signboard shall not exceed 3,6 sq. metres in area, and the lettering employed thereon shall not exceed 100 mm in height.

(4) In granting its approval in terms of Section 3 for the display of any sign referred to in sub-section (1), (2) or (3) the COUNCIL may grant such approval for a limited period only; on the expiry of such period the person displaying such sign shall forthwith remove it.

#### Signs on vehicles and signs carried through the street

16. (1) No person shall carry or cause to be carried through any public street any sandwich board, lantern, flag, banner, screen or other movable advertising device if such board, lantern, flag, banner, screen or other device hinders or obstructs traffic in such street, or is likely to do so.

(2) No person shall display any sign or cause any sign to be displayed on any vehicle, other than a taxi, unless the sign displayed or caused to be displayed is painted directly on the body of such vehicle.

(3) No person shall display or cause to be displayed on a taxi any sign other than a sign which -

(1) is painted directly on the body of such taxi and which indicates only the name of the person who or the firm which operates such taxi, or

(11) indicates only that the taxi is for hire as such, or

(111) is required by law to be displayed, and

(4) Any person who contravenes the provisions of sub-section (1), (2) or (3) shall be guilty of an offence.

(1) Nie meer as een sodanige advertensiebord mag op een enkele erf opgerig word nie; maar dit is toelaatbaar om die rigting na meer as een fabriek op enige sodanige advertensiebord aan te dui.

(11) Die inhoud van die advertensies op sodanige advertensiebord moet tot die name van die betrokke fabriek, die name van die okkuperders, en noodsaaklike rigtingsinligtinge beperk wees; en die letters wat gebruik word, mag nie meer as 100 mm hoog wees nie.

(3) Waar dit na sy mening redelikerwys vereis word, kan die RAAD die oprigting van 'n advertensiebord op 'n paal op 'n onbeboude erf in 'n dorpsgebied toelaat, met die doel om 'n kaart daarop te vertoon wat die straatname en erfnommers van sodanige dorpsgebied aantoon, tesame met die naam en adres van die eienaar van of agent vir sodanige dorpsgebied en die naam van die dorpsgebied. Sodanige advertensiebord mag 3,6 vk m in oppervlakte nie te bowe gaan nie, en die letters wat daarop gebruik word, mag 100 mm in hoogte nie te bowe gaan nie.

(4) By die verlening van sy goedkeuring kragtens artikel 3 vir die vertoning van enige advertensie waarna in subartikel (1), (2) of (3) verwys word, kan die RAAD sodanige goedkeuring net vir 'n beperkte tydperk verleen; by die verstryking van sodanige tydperk moet die persoon wat sodanige advertensie vertoon, dit onmiddellik verwyder.

#### Advertensies op voertuie en advertensies wat deur die straat gedra word

16. (1) Niemand mag enige plakkaatbord, lantern, vlag, banier, skerm of ander beweegbare advertensiemiddel deur enige openbare straat dra of laat dra indien sodanige bord, lantern, vlag, banier, skerm of ander middel die verkeer in sodanige straat hinder of versper of dit waarskynlik kan doen nie.

(2) Niemand mag enige advertensie vertoon of toelaat dat enige advertensie vertoon word op enige voertuig behalwe 'n taxi nie, tensy die advertensie wat vertoon word of toegelaat word om vertoon te word, direk op die bakwerk van sodanige voertuig geverf is.

(3) Niemand mag 'n advertensie op 'n taxi vertoon of toelaat dat dit daarop vertoon word nie behalwe 'n advertensie -

(1) wat direk op die bakwerk van sodanige taxi geverf is en wat net die naam van die persoon of die firma wat sodanige taxi bestuur, aandui, of

(11) wat net aandui dat die taxi as sodanig teen huur ry, of

(111) waarvan daar by wet vereis word dat dit vertoon moet word, en

(4) Iedereen wat die bepalinge van subartikel (1), (2) of (3) oortree, is skuldig aan 'n misdryf.

## Illuminated signs

17. (1) No flashing sign displayed outside a building shall be less than 9 m in clear height.

(2) No illuminated sign shall be displayed outside a building or inside a shop window in such a position that it is or is likely to be a danger to traffic or cause confusion with traffic signals.

(3) No sign that is so intensely illuminated as to create a nuisance shall be displayed.

## Structural requirements

18. (1) Every sign affixed to a building or structure shall be rigidly attached thereto. Every sign which is affixed to the ground and every structure supporting a sign, which structure is affixed to the ground, shall be rigidly anchored to the ground. Every sign and its supports and anchorages, and the building or structure, if any, to which it is affixed, shall be of adequate strength to resist, with a safety factor of 4, the dead load of the sign and a superimposed horizontal wind pressure of  $1,500 \text{ N/m}^2$ .

(2) All signs and supports thereof which are attached to brickwork or masonry shall be attached thereto by means of expansion bolts or by means of bolts passing through such brickwork or masonry and secured on the opposite side thereof. Such bolts shall be not less than 12 mm in diameter.

(3) Every sign affixed to a building or a wall shall be supported by at least four independent supports so designed and disposed that any two of such supports will safely support the sign with a safety factor of 2.

(4) All exposed metalwork in a sign or its supports shall be painted or otherwise treated to prevent corrosion and all timber in a sign or its supports shall be treated with creosote or other preservative to prevent decay.

(5) Every person displaying a sign shall cause such sign and its supports to be maintained in a safe condition at all times, and any person who contravenes the provisions of this sub-section shall be guilty of an offence.

## Use of glass

19. All glass used in signs (other than glass tubing in neon and similar signs) shall be plate glass at least 5 mm thick.

## Verligte advertensies

17. (1) Geen flitsende advertensie wat buite 'n gebou vertoon word, mag 'n onbelemmerde hoogte van minder as 9 m hê nie.

(2) Geen verligte advertensie mag buite 'n gebou of binne 'n winkelvenster in so 'n posisie vertoon word dat dit 'n gevaar vir die verkeer is of waarskynlik kan wees of verwarring met verkeerstekens kan veroorsaak nie.

(3) Geen advertensie wat so skerp verlig is dat dit 'n oorsak veroorsaak, mag vertoon word nie.

## Struktuurvereistes

18. (1) Elke advertensie wat aan 'n gebou of struktuur bevestig is, moet stewig daaraan vasgemaak wees. Elke advertensie wat aan die grond bevestig is en elke struktuur wat 'n advertensie stut en wat aan die grond bevestig is, moet onbeweeglik aan die grond geanker wees. Elke advertensie en stutte en verankerings daarvan, en die gebou of struktuur, indien daar is, waaraan dit bevestig is, moet sterk genoeg wees om met 'n veiligheidsfaktor van 4 die dooie las van die advertensie en 'n opgeleide horisontale winddruk van  $1,500 \text{ N/m}^2$  te kan weerstaan.

(2) Alle advertensies en die stutte daarvan wat aan messel- of klipwerk bevestig is, moet daaraan bevestig wees deur middel van uitdyboute, of deur middel van bonte wat deur sodanige messel- of klipwerk loop en aan die teenoorgestelde kant daarvan bevestig is. Sodanige bonte mag nie minder as 12 mm in deursnee wees nie.

(3) Elke advertensie wat aan 'n gebou of muur bevestig is, moet gestut wees deur minstens vier onafhanklike stutte wat so ontwerp en geplaas is dat enige twee sodanige stutte die advertensie veilig met 'n veiligheidsfaktor van 2 sal stut.

(4) Alle blootgestelde metaalwerk in 'n advertensie of die stutte daarvan moet geverf of anders behandel word om korrosie te voorkom, en alle houtwerk in 'n advertensie of die stutte daarvan moet met kreosoot of 'n ander bewaarmiddel behandel word om verrotting te voorkom.

(5) Elke persoon wat 'n advertensie vertoon, moet sodanige advertensie en die stutte daarvan te alle tye in 'n veilige toestand in stand hou, en enige persoon wat die bepalings van hierdie subartikel oortree, is aan 'n misdryf skuldig.

## Gebruik van glas

19. Alles glas wat in advertensies gebruik word (uitgesonderd glasbuis wat in neon- en dergelyke advertensies gebruik word) moet spieëiglas wees wat minstens 5 mm dik is.



## Materials for signs

20. (1) Except as in sub-sections (2), (3) and (4) provided, all signs and supports thereof shall be incombustible, durable materials.

(2) Any sign referred to in Section 22, and the supports thereof may be of materials which are combustible or are not durable.

(3) The COUNCIL may permit any sign approved in terms of Section 14 or Section 15, and the supports thereof, to be of materials which are combustible or are not durable.

(4) Flags affixed to flagpoles complying with the Municipal Building By-laws and not projecting over a street may be used for the display of signs, subject to the provisions of Section 6.

(5) Where any sign referred to in sub-section (2), (3) or (4) becomes torn, damaged or otherwise unsightly the person displaying such sign shall forthwith remove it.

## Electrical requirements

21. (1) No sign shall be illuminated except by electricity from the COUNCIL's mains.

(2) Every sign in connection with which electric current is used shall be provided with suitable condensers to prevent interference with radio reception.

## Exemptions.

22. (1) The provisions of this by-law shall not apply to any sign inside a building, except illuminated signs in shop windows.

(2) There shall be exempted from the provisions of sections 3, 14, 15 and 20 any sign that falls into one or other of the following categories:-

(i) Any sign displayed by the COUNCIL or by any omnibus or tramway company lawfully authorised to conduct a system of transport for use by the public, and any sign affixed to a bus shelter owned by the COUNCIL or to a street pole with the written permission of the COUNCIL, subject to such conditions, including the levying of fees and deposits, as the COUNCIL may impose.

(ii) Any sign inside a shop window.

(iii) Any advertisement appearing in a newspaper or periodical sold in the streets, and any poster in connection therewith.

## Materiaal vir advertensies

20. (1) Behalwe soos bepaal word in subartikels (2), (3) en (4), moet alle advertensies en die stutte daarvan uit onontvlambare, duursame materiaal bestaan.

(2) Enige advertensie waarna in artikel 22 verwys word, en die stutte daarvan, kan uit materiaal bestaan wat ontvlambaar is of nie duursaam is nie.

(3) Die RAAD kan toelaat dat enige advertensie wat kragtens artikel 14 of artikel 15 goedgekeur is, en die stutte daarvan, uit materiaal bestaan wat ontvlambaar is of wat nie duursaam is nie.

(4) Vlag bevestig aan vlagpale wat aan die Munisipale Bouregulasies voldoen en wat nie oor 'n straat uitsteek nie, kan vir die vertoon van advertensies gebruik word, onderworpe aan die bepalings van artikel 6.

(5) Waar enige advertensie waarna in subartikel (2), (3), of (4) verwys word, geskeur, beskadig of andersins onooglik raak, moet die persoon wat sodanige advertensie vertoon, dit onmiddellik verwyder.

## Elektrisiteitsvereistes

21. (1) Geen advertensie mag verlig word nie behalwe deur middel van elektrisiteit van die RAAD se hoofleiding.

(2) Elke advertensie in verband waarmee elektriese stroom gebruik word, moet van geskikte condensators voorsien word om storing in radio-ontvangs te voorkom.

## Vrystellings

22. (1) Die bepalings van hierdie verordening is nie op enige advertensie in 'n gebou, behalwe verligte advertensies in winkelvensters, van toepassing nie.

(2) Enige advertensie wat binne die bestek van die een of ander van die volgende klasse val, is van die bepalings van artikels 3, 14, 15 en 20 vrygestel:-

(i) Enige advertensie wat deur die RAAD of deur enige bus- of trammaatskappy wat wettig gemagtig is om 'n vervoersteisel vir gebruik deur die publiek te bestuur, vertoon word en enige advertensie wat, met die skriftelike toestemming van die RAAD aan 'n buskuiling wat aan die RAAD behoort of, aan 'n straatpaal bevestig word, onderworpe aan enige voorwaardes, met inbegrip van die heffing van gelde en deposito's wat die RAAD opleë, toe te voeg.

(ii) Enige advertensie binne 'n winkelvenster.

(iii) Enige advertensie wat in 'n koerant of tydskrif verskyn wat in die strate verkoop word, en enige plakkaat in verband daarmee.

(iv) Any sign temporarily displayed on the occasion of -

(a) any public thanksgiving, rejoicing or mourning, of

(b) any other public function or occasion to which the COUNCIL may apply the provisions of this paragraph.

(v) Any sign displayed in accordance with the provisions of subsections (2) and (3) of section 16 on a vehicle ordinarily in motion upon a public street and any sign carried through a public street.

(vi) Any unilluminated sign not projecting over a public street and not exceeding 0,6 square metres in area, notifying only that the premises to which it is attached are to be sold on a date specified in such sign, or that a sale of furniture or household goods is to take place therein on a date specified in such sign (neither of which dates shall be more than one month after the date when the sign is first displayed); provided that not more than two such signs are displayed on any public street frontage of such premises and that every such sign is removed within seven days after the said specified date.

(vii) Any unilluminated sign not projecting over a public street and not exceeding 0,6 square metres in area, notifying only that the premises to which it is attached are for sale or to let or that lodgers and boarders may be received therein; provided that only one such sign is displayed on any public street frontage of such premises; provided that in the case of premises comprising a factory or a factory site in an industrial zone such sign may exceed 0,6 square metres in area but shall not exceed 3,6 square metres in area.

(viii) Any unilluminated sign not projecting over a public street and not exceeding 1,2 square metres in area, comprising only the name, address and telephone number of any building or premises not used for purposes of industry or trade, and attached to such premises; provided that only one such sign is displayed on any public street frontage of such premises.

(iv) Enige advertensie wat tydelik vertoon word by geleentheid van -

(a) enige openbare danksegging, vreugde- of roubetoning, of

(b) enige ander openbare plegtigheid of geleentheid waarop die RAAD die bepalings van hierdie paragraaf van toepassing maak.

(v) Enige advertensie wat in ooreenstemming met die bepalings van subartikels (2) en (3) van artikel 16 vertoon word op 'n voertuig wat gewoonlik op 'n openbare straat beweeg en enige advertensie wat deur 'n openbare straat gedra word.

(vi) Enige onverligte advertensie wat nie oor 'n openbare straat uitsteek nie en hoogstens 0,6 vierkante meter in oppervlakte is, wat alleenlik bekend maak dat die perseel waaraan dit bevestig is, verkoop gaan word op 'n datum wat in sodanige advertensie vermeld word, of dat 'n verkoping van meubels of huusraad daarin gaan plaasvind op 'n datum wat in sodanige advertensie vermeld word (geeneen van sodanige datums mag later as 'n maand wees na die datum waarop die advertensie vir die eerste maal vertoon word nie), met dien verstande dat hoogstens twee sodanige advertensies vertoon word op enige openbare straatvoorkant van sodanige perseel en dat elk sodanige advertensie binne sewe dae na die genoemde datum verwyder word.

(vii) Enige onverligte advertensie wat nie oor 'n openbare straat uitsteek nie en hoogstens 0,6 vierkante meter in oppervlakte is, wat alleenlik bekend maak dat die perseel waaraan dit bevestig is, te koop of te huur is of dat kamerhuurders en loseerders daarin opgeneem kan word; met dien verstande dat net een sodanige advertensie aan enige openbare straat-front van sodanige perseel vertoon word; met dien verstande dat in die geval van 'n perseel bestaande uit 'n fabriek of 'n fabriekperseel in 'n nywerheidsone, sodanige advertensie 0,6 vierkante meter in oppervlakte mag oorskry maar nie 3,6 vierkante meter in oppervlakte mag oorskry nie.

(viii) Enige onverligte advertensie wat nie oor 'n openbare straat uitsteek nie en hoogstens 1,2 vierkante meter in oppervlakte is, wat alleenlik die naam, adres en telefoonnommer bevat van enige gebou of perseel wat nie vir nywerheids- of bedryfsdoeleindes gebruik word nie, en wat aan sodanige perseel bevestig is; met dien verstande dat net een sodanige advertensie aan enige openbare straat-front van sodanige perseel vertoon word.

(ix) Any unilluminated sign not projecting over a public street and not exceeding 0,2 square metres in area, notifying only the types of trade, business, industry or profession lawfully conducted by any occupant of the premises to which it is attached, the name of such occupant, the address and telephone number of such premises and the hours of attendance (if any); provided that only one such sign is displayed by any occupant on any public street frontage of such premises.

(x) Any unilluminated sign not projecting over such public street and not exceeding 3,0 square metres in area, advertising a function to be conducted on a date specified in such sign on the premises to which it is attached; provided that such function is not conducted for the private gain of any individual; provided further that such date is not more than one month after the date when such sign is first displayed; and provided lastly that only one such sign is displayed on any public street frontage of such premises and that it is removed within seven days after the said specified date.

(xi) Any unilluminated sign not projecting over such public street, which serves only for purposes of warning or indication of direction in relation to the premises to which such sign is attached, and which is no bigger or higher than is reasonably necessary for the effectual performance of its functions.

(xii) Any sign painted directly on, or forming part of the permanent fabric of, a wall of a building.

(xiii) Any sign painted or otherwise executed on the glass of any window.

(xiv) Any sign painted directly on a verandah or balcony if it complies with Section 11.

(xv) Any sign required to be displayed by law.

(xvi) Any sign displayed at premises upon which building operations are actually taking place and relating to any services being provided, work being done or goods being supplied in connection with such building operations; provided that -

(a) any such sign shall be removed forthwith when such building operations have been completed or if such building operations are discontinued or when the provision of the services, the doing of the work or the supply of the goods to which it relates has ceased;

(ix) Enige onverligte advertensie wat nie oor 'n openbare straat uitsteek nie en hoogstens 0,2 vierkante meter in oppervlakte is, wat alleenlik die soort bedryf, besigheid, nywerheid of beroep bekend maak wat wettig deur enige okkuperder van die perseel waaraan dit bevestig is, gedryf of uitgeoefen word, die naam van sodanige okkuperder, die adres en telefoonnommer van sodanige perseel en die spreekure (indien enige); met dien verstande dat net een sodanige advertensie deur enige okkuperder aan enige openbare straat-front van sodanige perseel vertoon word.

(x) Enige onverligte advertensie wat nie oor 'n openbare straat uitsteek nie en hoogstens 3,0 vierkante meter in oppervlakte is, wat 'n byeenkoms adverteer wat op 'n datum in sodanige advertensie bepaal en op die perseel waaraan dit bevestig is, gaan plaasvind; met dien verstande dat sodanige byeenkoms nie vir die rekening van enige persoon plaasvind nie; voorts met dien verstande dat sodanige datum nie later is as een maand ná die datum waarop sodanige advertensie vir die eerste maal vertoon word nie; en ten slotte met dien verstande dat net een sodanige advertensie aan enige openbare straat-front van sodanige perseel vertoon word en dat dit binne sewe dae ná genoemde bepaalde datum verwyder word.

(xi) Enige onverligte advertensie wat nie oor 'n openbare straat uitsteek nie, wat alleenlik bedoel is as 'n waarskuwing of aanduiding van rigting met betrekking tot die perseel waaraan sodanige advertensie bevestig is, en wat nie groter of hoër is as wat redelik nodig is vir die doeltreffende werkverrigting daarvan nie.

(xii) Enige advertensie wat regstreeks geverf is op, of deel uitmaak van die permanente struktuurwerk van 'n muur van 'n gebou.

(xiii) Enige advertensie wat op die glas van enige venster geverf of op 'n ander wyse daarop uitgewerk is.

(xiv) Enige advertensie wat regstreeks op 'n veranda of balkon geverf is, as dit aan artikel 11 voldoen.

(xv) Enige advertensie wat by wet vertoon moet word.

(xvi) Enige advertensie wat op 'n perseel waarop boubedryghede werklik aan die gang is, vertoon word en wat betrekking het op enige dienste wat gelewer, werk wat verrig of goedere wat verskaf word in verband met sodanige boubedryghede; met dien verstande dat -

(a) enige sodanige advertensie onmiddellik verwyder moet word wanneer sodanige boubedryghede voltooi is of indien sodanige boubedryghede gestaak word of wanneer die lewering van die dienste, die verrigting van die werk of die verskaffing van die goedere waarop dit betrekking het, opgehou het;

(b) the CITY ENGINEER may require the removal of any such sign if he is of the opinion that such building operations have been substantially completed or discontinued or that the provision of the services, the doing of the work or the supply of the goods to which it relates has for all practical purposes ceased, and such sign shall thereupon be removed forthwith; and

(c) If such premises consist wholly or partly of residential land, not more than one such sign relating to any particular service, work or goods shall be displayed, no such sign shall exceed 1,20 m<sup>2</sup> in area and the aggregate area of all such signs shall not exceed 3,60 m<sup>2</sup>.

(xvii) Any sign displayed at premises upon which a new building is being erected and relating to accommodation being offered to let in such building; provided that -

(a) any such sign shall be removed within 60 days after the date upon which the accommodation to which it relates is reasonably capable of occupation;

(b) the CITY ENGINEER may require the removal of any such sign if he is of the opinion that more than 60 days have passed since the date upon which the accommodation to which it relates was reasonably capable of occupation, and such sign shall thereupon be removed forthwith; and

(c) If such premises consist wholly or partly of residential land, not more than one such sign shall be displayed so as to be visible from any one public street and no such sign shall exceed 1,20 m<sup>2</sup> in area.

Consents granted and conditions imposed under previous laws, etc.

23. Any consent granted by the COUNCIL and any conditions imposed by the COUNCIL in terms of any by-law which has been repealed in respect of the display of any existing sign shall, except as in Section 4 of the by-law provided, continue in force as if such by-law had not been repealed; provided that, notwithstanding the repeal of any such by-law, the COUNCIL may take any action in respect of anything done or omitted to be done, before such repeal, in contravention of such repealed by-law, as if such by-law had not been repealed.

(b) die STADSINGENIEUR die verwydering van enige sodanige advertensie kan voorskryf indien hy van mening is dat sodanige boubedrywighede in aansienlike mate voltooi of gestaak is of dat die lewering van die dienste, die verrigting van die werk of die verskaffing van die goedere waarop dit betrekking het, vir alle praktiese doeleindes opgehou het, en sodanige advertensie moet daarna onverwyld verwyder word; en

(c) Indien sodanige perseel in die geheel of gedeeltelik uit woongrond bestaan, nie meer as een sodanige advertensie wat op enige besondere diens, werk of goedere betrekking het, vertoon mag word, geen sodanige advertensie 1,20 m<sup>2</sup> in oppervlakte mag oorskry en die totale oppervlakte van al sodanige advertensies nie 3,60 m<sup>2</sup> mag oorskry nie.

(xvii) Enige advertensie wat op 'n perseel waarop 'n nuwe gebou opgerig word, vertoon word en wat betrekking het op akkommodasie wat in sodanige gebou te huur aangebied word; met dien verstande dat -

(a) enige sodanige advertensie verwyder moet word binne 60 dae na die datum waarop die akkommodasie waarop dit betrekking het, redelikerwys vir okkupasie geskik is;

(b) die STADSINGENIEUR die verwydering van enige sodanige advertensie kan voorskryf indien hy van mening is dat meer as 60 dae verloop het sedert die datum waarop die akkommodasie waarop dit betrekking het, redelikerwys geskik vir okkupasie was, en sodanige advertensie moet daarna onverwyld verwyder word; en

## Savings

24. (1) Nothing in this by-law contained shall be construed as affecting in any way rights belonging to, or duties imposed upon the COUNCIL as the body in whom is lawfully vested the ownership of, or the control over, any street or other place or thing whatsoever within the municipal area of the City of Cape Town.

(2) Nothing lawfully done by the COUNCIL or any employee thereof in the exercise of its or his powers or the execution of its or his duties under this by-law shall -

(a) relieve any person from full responsibility for ensuring that any sign displayed by him is in accordance with these by-laws and all other laws applicable thereto; or

(b) render the COUNCIL or any such employee liable to pay any compensation to any person injuriously affected by the exercise of such powers or the execution of such duties or to any person injuriously affected by the display of such sign.

## Waiver of By-law

25. The COUNCIL may if it deems it desirable so to do, waive compliance with or relax the provisions of any section of this by-law.

(1) Before acting in terms of subsection (1) in respect of any sign displayed in the area referred to in Schedule 4 the COUNCIL shall obtain the consent of the Administrator.

## Voorbehoud

24. ## Kwytskelding van Verordening

25. Die RAAD, kan indien hy dit gerade ag, afsien van vervulling van die bepalings van enige artikel van hierdie verordening, of die bepalings daarvan verslap.

(1) Voordat die RAAD optree kragtens subartikel (1) in verband met enige advertensie wat vertoon word in die gebied in Bylae 4 vermeld, moet die RAAD die toestemming van die Administrateur verkry.

26. By-law no. 1959 promulgated under Provincial Notice 182 dated 11th March 1955, as amended, is hereby repealed.



4. Posters are to be attached to Council electric light poles only. They are not to be affixed to trees, traffic light poles, or other poles which carry traffic signs, walls, fences, rocks, other natural features or other Municipal property.
5. Posters may not be pasted on poles but are to be mounted on board and affixed securely with stout string.
6. No pole is to be used for the display of more than one poster.
7. No poster may be displayed within 30 m of any traffic signal, yield sign or stop sign.
8. The posters may not be displayed more than 4 days before the date of the function. They must be removed within 3 days after the date of function shown on the poster, and must be returned to this Department within 4 days of the date stamped on the poster, in order to qualify for a refund of the deposit.
9. The display of these posters is prohibited in the Foreshore area, on any bridge, and along the following roads:-
  - 9.1 Eastern Boulevard from Strand Street to De Waal Drive.
  - 9.2 De Waal Drive, from its junction with Jutland Avenue and including the overhead bridge in Roeland Street.
  - 9.3 Rhodes Drive.
  - 9.4 Union Avenue.
  - 9.5 Black River Parkway, including the section of Milner Road as far as the end of the dual carriageway.
  - 9.6 Liesbeek Parkway, to Camp Ground Road.
  - 9.7 Settlers Way.
  - 9.8 Beach Road from Mouille Point to Bantry Bay.
  - 9.9 Victoria Road from Bantry Steps to Bakoven Municipal boundary.
  - 9.10 Camps Bay Drive.
  - 9.11 Kloof Nek Road from Bellevue Street to Kloof Nek.
  - 9.12 Kloof Road, through the Glen, Camps Bay.
  - 9.13 Boyes Drive.
  - 9.14 Baden Powell Drive, Muizenberg.
10. Any poster not removed by due date referred to in 8, shall be removed by the Council.
11. / -

11. The display of unauthorised posters is illegal and such posters will be removed by the Council.
12. Any poster displayed in contravention of the abovementioned conditions, shall also be removed by the Council.
13. Kindly note that in terms of Section 5(9) of Regulation 1959, the Council may recover the costs in and as a result of the removal of unauthorised posters, and the reinstatement of the surface from which such posters were removed, from the person/s responsible for the display of such posters.

ONE-PERSON STANDS IN THE MUNICIPAL AREA OF CAPE TOWN

Your letter dated 1986-08-26 refers.

There is no objection from a traffic control point of view to your Organisation holding one-person stands from 07h00 to 19h00 for the period 1986-09-01 to 1986-09-06, on the pavement in the vicinity of the sites set out in this letter.

Kindly note that the picketers shall not stand within 10 metres of traffic signals, corners or intersections, nor shall they stand on the centre median in any road.

The sites are as follows:

2. Victoria Road, Woodstock, between Salt River and Greatmore Roads.

59. High Level Road, Green Point, between York and Vesperdene Roads.
60. Beach Road, Three Anchor Bay, between Penarth and Three Anchor Bay Roads.
61. Main Road, Green Point, between York and Varney's Roads.
62. Beach Road, Sea Point, between Arthur and Worcester Roads.

The permission is granted in terms of the Traffic By-Law promulgated under Provincial Notice 1117 of 1973-12-14, subject to the following conditions:

1. that all traffic laws shall be obeyed;
2. that the instructions of any uniformed Law Enforcement Officer of the Council shall be complied with;
3. that no undue obstruction shall be caused to pedestrian or vehicular traffic;
4. that each placard holder shall be in possession of a copy of this letter, to be produced on demand to any uniformed Law Enforcement Officer of the Council;
5. that no member of your Organisation shall stand on the centre islands or within 10 metres of traffic signals, corners or intersections;
6. that your Organisation ensures that before it undertakes the holding of the event in question it is fully in possession of all necessary authorities, if any, which may be required; and
7. that the Council reserves the right to withdraw the foregoing in whole or in part at any stage should it be deemed desirable to do so.

I wish to stress that the permit hereby granted is issued solely in terms of the Traffic By-law, the Council having satisfied itself that the "one-person stands" applied for are not likely to endanger, obstruct or interfere with pedestrian or vehicular traffic, any public market, any other meeting or any other lawful use of the public street. This authority does not, however, give any permission required in terms of any other legislation in force.

The legality of these "one-person stands" in terms of the recently promulgated emergency regulations has been questioned, however, and for this reason it is suggested that you satisfy yourself in this connection by enquiring from the appropriate authority.
