- 10<sup>th</sup> S.H. & S.F.C. rested. S.S. in charge. S.A. to Church. Mr. Ryecraft called. S.H. went to meeting at Bishop's House. You to see Mr. Ryecraft. Rector called.

Mr. Cole said Mass. S.G. went out to see Dasport with Mr. Goodwin by D & F bus. Mr. Richardson came in the morning to take Cheryl. Malron still in bed. Mr. Chamberlain called with Miss Russell to bring some washing. S: Grace came down. No one went up to Hospital.
