It's great news that Bob Sobukwe is to be freed. Now one must wait and see what restrictions they are going to place on him. I am fearful about these.

In the meantime, it strikes me that, over the years, Bob has accumulated a formidable mass of goods on the Island: books, clothing, bedding, heaters, easy chairs, radio, radiogram, etc., all of which are his own property. I was wondering whether it might be possible for you to make a quiet approach to the Minister to ask him if the authorities will ensure that all these things are packed up and shipped home for Bob. It would be a decent gesture if the State would bear the costs. The furniture and goods of warders transferred to and from the Island are regularly shipped so there must be a definite arrangement in existence about this sort of thing.

As always, I hope you will not mind my approaching you. Hope you are well.
