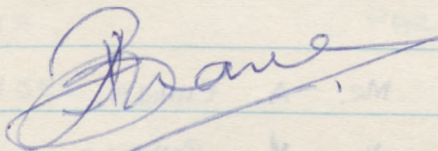

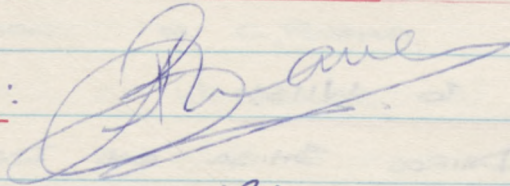

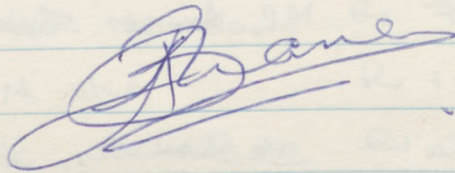
CAPTAIN'S REPORT.
