MEDICO-LEGAL REPORT.

NAME : MR STEPHEN MAVIMBELA

DATE OF BIRTH : 1953

OCCUPATION : SELF EMPLOYED

DATE OF EXAMINATION: 25/08/1993

HISTORY

At approximately 9 p.m. on 08/04/1992 Mr Stephen Mavimbela was assaulted with the butt of a rifle on his left arm and on his head.

As a result of the assault he sustained a cut over his left forehead, a cut over his left forearm and a fracture of his left hand.

2/...During

During the assault he fell to the ground but says that he did not lose consciousness.

He was taken by ambulance to the Natalspruit Hospital the next day. There X-rays were taken of his left forearm and he was told that he had a fracture of his second finger and the wounds on his forehead and left forearm were stitched. A cast was applied to his left forearm.

The cast was removed after approximately one month.

At this stage the sutures in his arm were removed.

While the cast was on he experienced severe pain in his hand and required tablets to control this pain.

Following removal of the cast the pain subsided, however since then he has been unable to lift heavy objects as this causes pain. He also experiences occasional pain in his hand during cold weather.

PRESENT COMPLAINTS

When he lifts heavy objects his left hand tires quickly. His left hand is not as strong as the right as it was prior to the assault.

GENERAL HEALTH PRIOR TO THE ASSAULT

His general health was good. He was on no medications, and he had no problems with his left hand or arm.

EMPLOYMENT

At the time of the assault he had a Spaza shop where he sold cold drinks etc and transported people to various places of employment in a van.

Following the assault he was unable to work for a month as he was unable to drive and was obliged to hire extra help to take care of his business.

After one month he was able to do most things in his business however he was unable to carry heavy objects like cold drink crates and continues to need assistance for this.

SOCIAL AMENETIES

He finds that he is unable to hold his baby for a long time as his left hand tires rapidly. He is also unable to carry heavy objects as his left hand is not as strong as it was prior to the assault.

EXAMINATION FINDINGS

Mr Stephen Mavimbela appeared generally well.

SCARRING

There was a 2.5 cm by 4 mm curved lasceration over the dorso-lateral aspect of his left forearm.

There were two large stitch marks crossing this scar. There was an underlying depression in the contour of the forearm underlying the scar.

There was a 2 cm scar visible on his left forehead the remainder of the scar was hidden by hair but was palpable.

RELATED TO THE LEFT HAND

There was a tenderness and swelling over the second metacarpo-phalangeal joint there was also thickening along the shaft of the second metatarsal. There was a detectable reduction in grip strength of the left hand when compared to the right.

SPECIAL INVESTIGATIONS

X-rays of his left hand were taken on 25/08/1993 (Radiologists report enclosed).

DIAGNOSIS

As a result of the assault he sustained lascerations to his left forehead and left forearm. These have resulted in scars to these areas which will remain as permanent disfigurements.

RELATED TO THE LEFT HAND

He apparently sustained a fracture to his left second finger. The X-rays taken on 25/08/19993 do not show signs of a previous fracture but one must assume that this healed in very satisfactory position, however there remains tenderness and swelling of his second left metacarpo-phalangeal joint and some thickening over the shaft of the second metacarpal bone. This implies that some damage was done to the second metacarpo-phalangeal joint and that the damage is significant as it is present more than sixteen months following the assault.

PROGNOSIS AND FUTURE MEDICAL COSTS

At the present time it would be reasonable to treat Mr Mavimbela's left hand with physiotherapy and a course of an anti-inflammatory agent to try and settle the inflammation in the metacarpo-phalangeal joint. It would be reasonable to allow for ten such sessions of physiotherapy costing approximately R 100,00 each and an anti-inflammatory agent which would cost in the region of R 160,00. This teatment should improve his left hand function and settle his symptoms. However it is possible that further anti-inflammatory treatment may be necessary. It would be reasonable to allow a sum of R 480,00 for this purpose.

CONCLUSION

As a result of his assault on 08/04/1992 Mr Stephen
Mavimbela sustained lascerations to his forehead
and forearm these remain as permanent scars.
He also sustained an injury to his left hand with
resultant loss of function ot this hand.
His arm was placed in a plaster cast for approximately
one month which prevented him from working during
this period. Following this he continues to suffer
disability both at his work and in his social ameneties.

I find no reason to suspect that his life expectancy has been altered by this assault.



- 2. By the addition of the following alternative to paragraph 3 of Defendant's Plea (ad paragraph 3 of Plaintiff's Particulars of Claim):
 - "3.2 Alternatively and in the event of it being found that the Plaintiff was assaulted/that any physical act/s was/were committed against

the Plaintiff, as alleged or at all, by a member or members of the South African Defence Force, then the Defendant pleads as follows:

- 3.2.1 In terms of Government Notice No. 13519, Proclamation No. R2242 of 9 September 1991, the Minister of Law and Order in terms of Section 5A(1) of the Public Safety Act, No. 3 of 1953, declared that public disturbance, disorder, riot and public violence were occurring or threatening in inter alia the Tokoza area, as demarcated and described in Government Notice No. 511 of 10 April 1959, as amended, as from 9 September 1991. In terms of Proclamation No. R2243, 1991, of 9 September 1991, the Minister of Law and Order in terms of Section 5A of the Public Safety Act proclaimed certain regulations ("the Regulations"). Proclamations R2242 and R2243 were valid and in force on 8 April 1992.
- 3.2.2 Regulation 12(1) of the Regulations provides that no civil proceeding shall be instituted against any member of the Cabinet of the Republic of South Africa or any member of a Security Force by reason of any act in good faith advised, commanded, ordered, directed or performed by any person in the carrying out of his duties or the exercise of his powers or the performance of his functions in terms of the Regulations as therein more fully provided, with the intent to combat or to prevent public disturbance, disorder, riot or public violence or to maintain or to restore public order or for dealing with any circumstances which in his opinion have arisen or are likely to arise as a result of such public disturbance, disorder, riot or public violence or the combating or prevention thereof.

DEFENDANT'S AMENDED PLEA TO PLAINTIFF'S PARTICULARS OF CLAIM

1. **AD PARAGRAPH 1**:

Save to admit that Plaintiff is **Stephanie Stephen Mavimbela**, Defendant has no knowledge of the remaining allegations contained in this paragraph, accordingly denies same and puts Plaintiff to the proof thereof.

2. AD PARAGRAPH 2:

Defendant admits the contents of this paragraph.

3. **AD PARAGRAPH 3**:

Defendant denies the contents of this paragraph and puts Plaintiff to the proof thereof.

- Alternatively and in the event of it being found that the Plaintiff was assaulted/that any physical act/s was/were committed against the Plaintiff, as alleged or at all, by a member or members of the South African Defence Force, then the Defendant pleads as follows:
 - 3.2.1 In terms of Government Notice No. 13519, Proclamation No. R2242 of 9 September 1991, the Minister of Law and Order in terms of Section 5A(1) of the Public Safety Act, No. 3 of 1953, declared that public disturbance, disorder, riot and public violence were occurring or threatening in **inter alia** the Tokoza area, as demarcated and described in Government Notice No. 511 of 10 April 1959, as amended, as from 9 September 1991. In terms of Proclamation No. R2243, 1991, of 9 September 1991, the Minister of Law and Order in terms of Section 5A of the Public Safety Act proclaimed certain regulations ("the Regulations"). Proclamations R2242 and R2243 were valid and in force on 8 April 1992.

- 3.2.2 Regulation 12(1) of the Regulations provides that no civil proceeding shall be instituted against any member of the Cabinet of the Republic of South Africa or any member of a Security Force by reason of any act in good faith advised, commanded, ordered, directed or performed by any person in the carrying out of his duties or the exercise of his powers or the performance of his functions in terms of the Regulations as therein more fully provided, with the intent to combat or to prevent public disturbance, disorder, riot or public violence or to maintain or to restore public order or for dealing with any circumstances which in his opinion have arisen or are likely to arise as a result of such public disturbance, disorder, riot or public violence or the combating or prevention thereof.
- 3.2.3 The Defendant is a member of the Cabinet of the Republic of South Africa.
- 3.2.4 The member or members of the South African Defence Force, as alleged by the Plaintiff to have assaulted Plaintiff/committed physical acts against the Plaintiff, was a member/were members of a Security Force, as provided for in the Regulations.

- 3.2.5 The place at Phola Park, Tokoza, where the assault/
 physical acts allegedly took place, is a place where the
 said Proclamations were valid and binding as at 8 April
 1992.
- 3.2.6 The assault of/physical acts against Plaintiff was an act/were acts in good faith advised, commanded, ordered, directed or performed by a person or persons in the carrying out of his/their duties or the exercise of his/ their powers or the performance of his/their functions in terms of the Regulations, as more fully provided in Regulation 12(1).
- 3.2.7 In the premises the Plaintiff has no cause of action as alleged and is not entitled to institute the said action.

4. **AD PARAGRAPHS 4, 5, 6, 7 and 8**:

Defendant denies the contents of these paragraphs and puts Plaintiff to the proof thereof.

5. **AD PARAGRAPH 9**:

Defendant admits a demand and a failure or refusal to pay, but pleads that Defendant is not legally liable to pay the amount claimed or any portion thereof.

WHEREFORE Defendant prays that Plaintiff's claim be dismissed with costs.
