

It gives me great pleasure to congratulate the Institute of Administrators of Non-European Affairs on the occasion of its twentieth birthday.


On the threshold of a new era, I would like to express the hope that the Institute will always continue to watch impartially over the interests of its members and the cause to which it has dedicated itself.



SEKRETARIAAT

'n Permanente Sekretariaat vir die Instituut is met ingang 1 April 1970 ingestel. Hierdie stap is genoodsaak aangesien dit weens die toenemende volume, vir die Ere-Sekretaris onmoontlik geword het om die Sekretariële werk van die Instituut op 'n deeltydse basis te behartig.

Die eerste lede van die personeel het bestaan uit mnr. Alex Rabie, Administratiewe Beampie, mev. Alet Geeringh, Privaatsekretariesse en mev. Julie Baker, Klerk. In die loop van die jaar het mev. Baker bedank en is sy opgevolg deur mev. Boysen. mev. Boysen het egter ook die Sekretariaat verlaat en is sedert 22 Maart 1971 opgevolg deur mev. Lente Goldswain as Privaatsekretariesse. Mev. Geeringh is terselfdertyd bevorder tot Senior Vroueklerk en die benaming van mnr. Rabie se pos het verander na dié van Assistent Sekretaris.

SECRETARIATE

A permanent Secretariate of the Institute was established with effect from 1st April, 1970. This measure became necessary as the increased volume of the Secretarial work of the Institute made it impossible for the Hon. Secretary to cope with the work on a part time basis.

The first members of the staff consisted of Mr. Alex Rabie, Administrative Official, Mrs. Alet Geeringh, Private Secretary and Mrs. Julie Baker, Clerk. In the course of the year Mrs. Baker resigned and was succeeded by Mrs. Boysen. Mrs. Boysen however also left the Secretariate and since 22nd March, 1971 was succeeded by Mrs. Lente Goldswain as Private Secretary. Mrs. Geeringh was simultaneously promoted to Senior Clerk and the designation of Mr. Rabie changed to Assistant Secretary.
