- KB went to Irene for the Week-end leaving by 9.11 train. S.R.M. had Saturday jobs & classes as usual - S.D.M. took girls to the Clinic. S. Hughie to the Shelters - lots of Orland she had not seen.
- 10 Sunday - Trinity XVII. 6 o'clock Mass at St. Joseph's - 8 a.m. S. Hughie S.R.M. went to P.C.C. 11.30 - 1.35. F. Huddleston called about 3. Sister Hughie left at 3.30 for St. Catharines. S.D.M. took her to Joburg station for 4.30 train. Many visitors today.
- 11 S.R.M. & S.D.M. set off for Irene & arrived there about 11 a.m. After morning tea at Irene, S.R.M., S.D.M., Miss Paley, W. Broomhead & Sister Superior went to the D.S.L. & picnicked there. S.D.M. & Miss Paley returned to Irene & the other three went on to St. Mary's Warrenton. Had tea there. We arrived home about 6 p.m. <sup>going Vesper</sup> S.D.M.
12. Mass at 7 a.m. See his Fr. Libesko in Xosa.
- S.D.M. went to Clinic & Bridgeman. In the afternoon she took a job & court & another to the Birth Registration Office. S.S. took a letter to Newclare & post after tea. Mr. Robertson missed the train & did not come.
- 13 Mass at 7 a.m. Fr. Jenkins.
- S.D.M. took Olvie to the Eye Hospital & some children to clinic. After morning tea she went & got the vegetables & visited EK.
- In the afternoon - Board meeting at 3 p.m.
- S.D.M. went to bed early.

14 Mass at 6 a.m. S.S. rested till breakfast.

S.D.M. took Amy & Ege Hospital.

Muriel & Mary, two Methodist babies, were baptised in our chapel at 3.30 p.m. The time appointed was 12.0!

S.D.M. took Bernard & Clinic & went to library en route.

S.S. went to the Bank at Indutrois in the morning.

In Hororim S.S. went with a party to Garage House for a meeting of the Education League. It was a very important meeting. Dr. Tobias was in the chair - The speakers were Fr. Huddleston & an African connected with Race Relations & Senator Ballinger proposed the resolution which concerned St. Peter's School but also condemned the Education Act & demanded its immediate repeal. The Hall was packed with over 1200 people there. S.S. got back at 11 a.m. To Hororim Dr. Henderson called with her 'boss'.

15. S.S. & S.D.M. took Joansa to the Adoption Office & met Dr. Wellbould there re. Detention order for Rhodes. We had tea at a tea shop in between business. Bought English Novel for Arthur & the boys. Called at Native Commissioner's Office re. Joansa. In the afternoon Bernard was admitted to Bar. Hosp. Sheila Macaulay arrived for the week-end. Brought by Fr. Hooper.

S.D.M. went to bed early but was called up just as S.S. came out of chapel after office & deal with Native Affairs who had the baby to Banjapoint's Hosp. with a miscarriage. He fetched a nurse from the Clinic & kept us.

16. S.D.M. called at Bar. Hosp. & then at Bullock's home & Kellerman's then to Social Affairs to get a vegetable. Sheila accompanied to Bar. Hosp.

after tea J. S. took Sheila to Leesburg & drove around to Tabarac via Dabbe.

We were then busy making veils for the girls.

17. Mass at 6 a.m. & 8 a.m. Sheila went to Park & Monroe's tea. S.D.M. went to Bar. H. in the p.m. S.S. & R.B. took Sheila to damage house after tea. Car radiator leaking.
18. St. Luke's Day. Sung mass at 5.30 a.m. in English! — even the creed sung & Nicene! — At 7 a.m. the phone rang from the Police Station to ask us to fetch rail warrant for Leestgey & escort L.F. & Hennemann for a court case. We went along at 8.30 & after much argument & much time got the <sup>1.1.2</sup> ~~magistrate~~ warrant but J.S. had to take the two big cars to Park Station & get the ticket there. Arrived back after 10 a.m. after which S.D.M. went to the Bridgman & the Registration Office & arrived back late to dinner. We all rested in the afternoon. Tea at 3.30 after which S.S. & S.D.M. went to Leesburg for Coopersium & Redditors. On the way back we visited M<sup>t</sup>. Tabor. K. B. went with a party to the Shoe Party at S. Benedict's.
19. S. Friedewald. Mass at 7 a.m. S.D.M. had to take Anne & the Bridgman at 4.30 p.m. S.D.M. got the vegetables & groceries at Social Welfare in the afternoon. Classes at 10.30 & 11.30. S.S. gave class in Chapel at 7 p.m.
20. Mass at 7 a.m. M<sup>t</sup>. Tabor came about 11 a.m. & met M<sup>t</sup>. Githens & S.D.M. Job came with his assistant & the latter re-painted the ceiling of the front hall & S.R.M.'s cell.

We had a lovely picnic at the Woods, St. Louis,  
soon after 12.0 returning by 4.30.  
S.S. gave a class to the church girls in Chapel  
after Supper.

21 Mass at 6 a.m.

S.D.M. & S.S. went to town - S.S. to Builders' Society &

& picked cupboards & stable from Mrs. Morris at Northside.  
Morris came for James at 1 p.m. <sup>S.D.M. went to the early</sup>  
<sup>but was called back at 11.20 p.m. & took Shirley & Bridgman.</sup>

22. Mass at 4 p.m.

S.S., S.D.M., Natrona, Lelia, Bengt & Amy went to  
High School Speech Day at 2 p.m.

Mrs. Robertson came to take her class. S.S. took her  
back & called at Bridgman on the way.

F. Jenkins came to fix his class room home in the Dodge  
after he had repaired it. Two girls went with the  
work party to a concert at the University, first Hall.

23. Dedication Festival. Mass at 6.30. Fr. Evans.  
After breakfast we greeted Fr. Evans & found him  
with a bad throat. lent him a thermometer & took  
his temperature - 99.4 - recommended his going  
& Dr. Richards at the Clinic.

After saying 3 offices we stripped Chapel for  
painting. S.D.M. went to Baranowski Hospital.

S.S. met S.R. Mary at 10.30 at Hamlinburg St.  
Talking tea in the Committee Room.

Dr. Rothschild came to interview Mary Batyr  
about a job.

24. Sunday Trinity XIX. Mass b.a.m S.Mary's Synod Sun.  
All went to the Cathedral for 11 a.m Service when the  
Bishop gave his Charge. S.D.M. & Kathleen went again to the  
afternoon Service taking some girls. S.R.M. had classes as usual.

Miss Levett (from Chichester Eng) came to see S.R.H. arrived by 10:39 train S.D.M. met her at Hamletaking After tea saw Nursery Sch. + Grannie - stopped to lunch but had to return by 1:11 train. S.D.M. went to Social Welfare - Superior took Mrs Robertson home after her class.
- 27 S.D.M. took car to garage - returned home by train. Mr B. took S.R.H. visiting in Leesburg van. In the afternoon F Rebake took S.D.M. + 2 girls to fetch cupboard from Northcliffe - S.D.M. dropped at Winifred's to fetch the car.

Car not going well so called at Garage Got flowers at the Market Tools Florence to S. M. Hosp. came back via Bridgeman + brought back Shirley + baby. Superior took Mrs R. home for as train, had to go to the garage again. F Jenkins in evening.
- 30 Mass in Chapel: 6:30. F Jenkins - Amy, Rebecca + Muriel dismissed after Mass. Superior took S.B.R. to Ek. 9:30. Ecumenical Ann. Meeting 3 p.m. Sisters + Kathleen went. Speaker Mr Alan Paton - v good meeting. Amy & Rebecca both left. M. McVayle, F. of Christ the King. Trinity XX All went to 6:00 Mass St. M. S.D.M. took Grannie to 11:00 High Mass at Xr. the King. Superior was prevented because Muriel's Mother came v. late to fetch Muriel - they left in a great flap. and

probably missed their train! S. Phoebe & J. Viner
