Apr 19th

- Sr Enid went to meet Sr. Adelaide who arrived quite punctually. They came to the door in a motor with all the luggage for 3/- . Miss Old~~ham~~ came to tea
- 21 Pepper came and colour washed front room and did it very badly. Mrs Hewitt called.
- 22 All went to Bats' Cove picnicing and were caught in the rain just by the tram
- 23 Miss Hewitt came to tea
- 24 All to mass at 8:30. Sr. Ad. poorly did not go out again. Sr. Enid & Frederica went to Sung mass and Evensong
Mr Thompson called & promised to do the front room over again as it had been done so badly
Mrs Mitchell and the Misses Reynolds called and Frederica went out to tea.
- 25 Sr. Ad in ^{bed} all day till evening. Sr Enid went to East Bank paid bills and booked her seat.
- 26 Miss ^{Payne} ~~Sanders~~ called
- 27 Cold & v. windy. We stayed in all day.
- 28 Sr Ad. & Frederica went to the East Bank and did shopping. Mr Thompson color washed front room

April 30

Sr Enid went to East Bank to get some more paint - immediately after breakfast and then Sr Ad finished painting the room. Sr. E. finished the curtains. Sr. Gertrude Mary + Sr. Mary Joyce called in the evening.

May 1st

Sr. Enid + Sr. Ad went to 8 o'clock Mass - all went at 11 and to Evensong. Sr Enid called on Mr^s Mitchell after Evensong to wish her good bye.

2nd

We all went to station to see Sr. Enid off who left at 8.45. We had the motor at the door to call for us but we got off at the terminus instead of going on to the station as he wanted to charge 6/- which we thought too much. We gave him 3/6.

Fredica and Sr. Ad. got the saucepan from Dunkerley's where the handle had been mended for 1/- and came home. Out on the rocks after tea. Glorious weather.

3rd

Agnes did not come as she was not well. Rather wet very dull close day. Sr. Florence Louisa called but did not stay to any meals. Sr. Adelaide had to fill~~in~~ the Census papers.

4

Agnes came and did housework and brought a woman who did the washing. The collector called for the Census papers.

1921

May 5 Ascension Day. Sr. Ad. & Frederica went to Mass at 7.0'clock.
Had some time on the rocks but as it was a
cold wind stayed in the greater part of the
day. Frederica very tired went to bed directly
after supper. Sr. Ad. went to Benediction alone.
Benediction on Thursday instead of Friday this week.
6th Sr. Ad & Fr. went to Shelly Beach for a picnic
beautiful day but very windy. Home at 3.30
After tea Fr. ordered the car to meet Superior.

7th Saty. S. Ad. met Superior & Miss Hope at 7.15.
Mr. Reynolds met us & brought us all
over with our luggage. - Breakfast & rested
after tea S. Supr & S. Ad: went to St. Peter's
con to the rocks - all went early to bed.

8th Sunday All went to 8 o'clock & 11 o'clock Mass - Quiet
afternoon - Frederica went for a walk
with the Reynolds & back to supper with
them - all went to Pension.

9th Monday all rested. breakfast 8.30. S. Supr & S. Ad: went
over to E. London at 10.30. to bank place.
on train & do some shopping. returned
for dinner. rested in afternoon - Frederica
spent afternoon with the Reynolds. all
the night went out for abl. an hour.

10th Tues: Supr & S. Ad. to Mass. at 10.30 all climbed for
the Mercedes - talking dinner - W. we had
on the rocks - lovely day. had tea at
the Beach Tea House. S. Ad & Frederica
shopped - Miss H. & Supr. Came home - W. Hewitt
brought tomatoes & Mr. Cook flowers.

11th Wedg. Rested. Miss H. breakfast in bed. S. Ad. & Supr
started out at 10.45. I went down one side
of the Dock. & returned the Mercedes!

& Emily CR. came over at 4.30 - slept the night

19th Thurs. Supr. & Emily both had breakfast in bed - Supr.
could better - Rained in after: & Emily left 4.30

20th Friday Supr. in bed all day.

21st Sat. Superior up at 11. Mr. Hewitt sent round
books & magazines, flowers & tomatoes & came
in to tea at 4.15.

22nd Sunday Supr. not well and to go to early Mass
Trinity & Luis H. stayed at home too. both were
at 11. - & neither went to Whiteman

23rd Monday Miss Hope to early Mass. Supr. up at 11.15.
The Reeler came & brought butter & some beef
mixture for Supr. - Florrie Reynolds to tea.

24th Tues. The side board arrived at 7.30 a.m. - School
Treat. invited sup. not well and to go - heard

in afternoon: that Mother Florence & S. Emily, were going
for a few days. Supr. out for 2 actions.

25th Wedgy Supr. down to breakfast. S. Gertrude Mary CR.
Came over at 10. stayed to have Tea -
Mr. Jack came over & spent the afternoon.
Mr. Hewitt came over in the morning -

26th Thurs: Supr. & Miss H. to Early Mass. at 12. Mrs. H.
Corpus Christi. went over to E. Jordan. to do some shopping
returned by 2 o'clock. - Little Clara Knell &
Kathleen Clifford to tea. Miss H. went to
Benediction - Lettices & Tomatoes sent as

27th Friday Mother Florence & S. Emily CR. Came over
abt. 12.0. to stay a few days. Miss Pagn.
Came to see them after tea - Supr. to see
Mr. Reginald. & Mr. Cook.

28th Saty. M. Florence & S. Emily, rested till 10. Mr. Hewitt
Came to see them in morning. Miss H. went
over to the station to fetch some Eggs from Mrs.

29th Sunday To Mass at 8 (S. Emily, who rested) at 11.0. & to

30th Monday Mother Florence & Supr. to Early Mass - Quiet
morning on sleep. Mr. Hewitt came to say
good-bye to M. Florence, she & S. Emily left
at 12. - Supr. went over with them (a lady)

June 1921

Mother'd them, then today Good-bye to Miss Hewitt (Y.W.C.A.) who was leaving for England - Sup returned at 1.15. She & Miss Hope went for walk in the afternoon to the Native Location - While they were out a Mr Sharp (a used S. Mary's girl) called & left a lot of fruit.

31st Tues: Both rested - Mr. Hewitt called in the morning & brought corned beef - Public Holiday. Sup & Miss H. sat on the rocks in afternoon.

1st June Wed: Sup. went to Mass & left at 10.15 from Grahamstown. Travelling with the Rev. Mother -

2nd to 13th Sister Gertrude Mary C.R. Came to play at the Cottage.

14th Tues: S^r Superior returned from Grahamstown at 5.30 p.m.

15th Wed: Sup. had breakfast in bed - Showery all day till 6. very warm - Mr. Hewitt in afternoon - Sup & Miss Hope to morning.

16th Thurs: Sup to Mass. Miss H. breakfast in bed - Both went on to the Rocks & had dinner there. Sister Rose from S^r Cuthbert's, with her colored workmen & 2 girls arrived at 1.30 - S^r Rose & Sup went over to the East Bank. All to bed early.

17th Friday All rested. S^r R & Mary M. breakfast in bed. all

went to the sandy beach. Took our dinner
very windy. returned to tea at 3.45. G. Rae
then took her 3 girls off to S. Vondra to shop
Supper 6.15. all went to Benediction

18th Sat^y. All went to Mass & made their Com^o on
to the Rocks aft. breakf - dinner 12. 28.
R.S. her party left at 12.30 - to go on board
the "Kinfarn" enroute for Cape Town. Miss
H. & Sup^r. had High Tea at 5.30 - & to bed early

19th Sunday Both to Sick & Nock Service - met W. Palmer
(Grace Dieu) coming out of the latter - he was en
route to England. W. Mitchell came to tea
W. Anderson brought lettuce & raw laid eggs.

20th Monday Sup^r. breakf in bed - W. Chambers called
re. Hilda Symons. at 11.30. The Clifforde
holer took Sup^r. & Miss H. to Shelley Beach
had dinner & tea there - walked home. 5.30

21st Tues: Sup^r. to Early Mass - windy - quick Mass
in doors. extremely hot till 4 - both went
to walk & Sup^r. called on W. Hewitt.

22nd Wed^y Miss H. went over to meet Miss Nelson at 7.16
train punctual - Miss N. to bed for rest of the day.
Mr. Jack came to tea. W. Hewitt called at 5.30

23rd Thurs: Sup^r. to Early Mass. Miss N. in bed to breakfast

June 1921

Supr. went over to E. Jordan at 10.30 - to G. B. &
to the Sisters for dinner & tea. returned
at 5.30. The Miss Reynolds called

24th Friday Supr. Miss H. & Miss N. to Mass - lovely day.
S. John Bapt. took dinner & tea down to Rat Rock

25th Sat. all rested. breakf 8.30. Miss N. to Rocks.
Supr. to Reclary Church - to meet Miss N.
dinner 1. & at 2.30 all 3 went in the
Clifford's motor to Shelley Beach. late
tea with us. returned at 5. S. Dara &
arrived at 6.15 for the week-end.

26th Sunday. All went to Early Mass 7.11 o'clock.
saw Miss Clephane & Miss Tott after
the latter - they came to tea & supper.
All but Miss Nelson went to Services.

27th Monday. Sister Dara left at 7.45. Miss N. in bed all
day. Supr. v. heavy cold - up late - & bed
at 6. W. Charge. Miss Clephane & Miss Tott to tea.
Miss Reynolds came in 5. -

28th Tues. Supr. in bed till 11 - out for short time
Went to tea with Miss Clephane & Miss Tott.

29th Wed. All went to 7 o'clock Mass - Supr. went out
S. Peter. & paid bills - All had tea on Rat Rock
