Apr 19<sup>th</sup>

Sr. Erid went to meet Sr. Adelaide who arrived quite punctually. They came to the door in a motor with all the luggage for 3/- . Miss Old ~~bury~~ came to tea

- 21 Pepper came and colour washed front room and did it very badly. Mr. Hewitt called.
- 22 All went to Bats' Cave picnicing and were caught in the rain just by the tiams
- 23 Miss Hewitt came to tea
- 24 All to Mass at 8:30. Sr. Ad. poorly did not go out again. Sr. Erid & Frederica went to Sung Mass and Evensong  
Mr. Thompson called & promised to do the front room over again as it had been done so badly  
Mrs Mitchell and the Misses Reynolds called and Frederica went out to tea.
- 25 Sr. Ad. in bed all day till evening. Sr. Erid went to East Bank paid bills and booked her seat.
- 26 Miss <sup>Payne</sup> ~~Sawyers~~ called
- 27 Cold & v. windy. we stayed in all day.
- 28 Sr. Ad. & Frederica went to the East-Bank and did shopping. Mr. Thompson color washed front room Glorious day.
- 29 Sr. Ad. started painting front Room. All went to Benediction

- April 30 Sr. Erid went to East Bank to get some more paint immediately after breakfast and then Sr. Ad finished painting the room. Sr. E. finished the curtains. Sr. Grebrud Mary & Sr. Mary Joyce called in the evening.
- May 1<sup>st</sup> Sr. Erid & Sr. Ad went to 8 o'clock Mass - all went at 11 and to Evening. Sr. Erid called on Mr. Mitchell after Evening to wish her good bye.
- 2<sup>nd</sup> We all went to station to see Sr. Erid off who left at 8.45. We had the motor at the door to call for us but we got off at the terminus instead of going on to the station as he wanted to charge 6/- which we thought too much. We gave him 3/6. Fredrica and Sr. Ad. got the suspension from Dunkerleys where the handle had been mended for 1/- and came home. Out on the rocks after tea. Glorious weather.
- 3<sup>rd</sup> Agnes did not come as she was not well. Rather wet very dull close day. Sr. Florence Louisa called but did not stay to any meals. Sr. Adelaide had to fill in the Census papers.
- 4 Agnes came and did housework and brought a woman who did the washing. The collector called for the Census papers.

May 5 Ascension Day. Sr. Ad. & Frederica went to Mass at 7 o'clock. Had some time on the rocks but as it was a cold wind stayed in the greater part of the day. Frederica very tired went to bed directly after supper. Sr Ad. went to Benediction alone Benediction on Thursday instead of Friday this week.

6<sup>th</sup>

Sr. Ad & Fr. went to Shelley Beach for a picnic beautiful day but very windy. Home at 3.30 After tea Fr. ordered the car to meet Superior.

7<sup>th</sup>: Saty. S. Ad. met Superior & Miss Hope at 7.15. Mr. Reynolds met us & brought us all over with our luggage - Breakfast & rested after tea S. Supt & S. Ad: went to St. Peter's down to the rocks - all went early to bed.

8<sup>th</sup>: Sunday all went to 8 o'clock & 11 o'clock Mass - Grinch afternoon - Frederica went for a walk with Mr. Reynolds & back to Supper with them - all went to Greensong.

9<sup>th</sup>: Monday all rested. breakfast 8.30. S. Supt & S. Ad: went over to E. London at 10.30. to book places on train & do some shopping. returned for dinner. rested in afternoon. Frederica spent afternoon with Mr. Reynolds. all the English went out for abt. an hour.

fish also Mr. Krieg - Mr. Hewitt called  
to say Miss W. is to be in Bendleton in the evening.  
Early tea - took walk on the rocks.
- 14<sup>th</sup>. Satg. Rested - Supr. to see Dr. about her ear. She &  
Whitman are Miss Hope to Ch: in Supr.
- 15<sup>th</sup>. Whitman Mass at 8 & 11. very high wind &  
D. cold all day. Mr. Miss Reynolds came to  
tea. all went to Gouesone.

- 16<sup>th</sup> Monday Supr. & Luis Hope to Thurs. 7. "Tom" a Colored  
Whiteman Waiter came at 7.45 to do odd jobs in  
the house - glorious day wind gone down.  
Sat on rocks in after: The Reeler called  
I had tea with us.
- 17<sup>th</sup> Tuesday Supr & Luis Hope to Thurs. 7. & took dinner  
Whiteman Tuesdays to the rocks at 11.45. returned at 3.30.  
Supper early, I left. to bed at 7. r. poorly
- 18<sup>th</sup>. Wedg. Supr poorly did not get up till 3 o'clock  
G. Emily CR. came over at 4.30 - slept the night
- 19<sup>th</sup>. Thurs Supr. & G. Emily both had breakf. in bed - Supr  
Cold better. Rained in after: G. Emily left 4.30
- 20<sup>th</sup>. Friday Supr. in bed all day.
- 21<sup>st</sup>. Sat Superior up at 11. Mr. Hewitt sent round  
books & magazines, flowers & tomatoes & came  
in to tea at 4.15.
- 22<sup>nd</sup>. Sunday Supr. not well so we go to Early Mans  
Trinity & Luis H. stayed at home too. both went  
at 11. - & neither went to church
- 23<sup>rd</sup>. Monday This Hope to Early Mans. Supr up at 11.15.  
The Reeler came & brought butter & some fresh  
mixture for Supr. Harris Reynolds to tea.
- 24<sup>th</sup>. Tues: The side board arrived at 7.30 a.m. - S. School  
Treat. invited my not well so to go - Deard

till 6. very warm - Mr. Hewitt in afternoon - Sup  
& Miss Hope to town.

16<sup>th</sup>: Thurs: Sup to Mass. Miss H. breakf in bed - both  
went on to the Rocks & had dinner. Her  
Sister Rose from St. Cuthbert's, with her colored  
worker & 2 girls arrived at 1.30 - S. Rose & S. Superior  
went over to the East Bank. All to bed early.

day. Supp. v. heavy. Cold - up late - 9 o'clock  
at 6. W. Charge. Miss Clephane. Miss Tott to tea.  
Miss Reynolds came in 5. -

28<sup>th</sup>. Tues. Supp. in bed till 11 - went for short time  
went to tea with Miss Clephane & Miss Tott.

29<sup>th</sup>. Wed<sup>g</sup>. All went to 7 o'clock Mass - Huf. went to  
S. Peter. & paid bills - All had tea on Rat Rock
