Dear Mrs Robb,

I have just had a letter from Mrs Henderson in regard to the supply of fruit for Bob Sobukwe. She mentioned that she was about to go overseas, and suggested that I write to you about the matter.

Coincidentally, on Saturday I had a letter from Bob in which he reported that Stuttafords were now sealing the parcels of fruit, as requested by him. My thanks to you and Mrs Henderson in bringing this about.

Bob also said that he had decided to cut down the supply of fruit to once a fortnight, instead of getting it weekly. As he put it: "I am getting on in years, young man, and have to regulate my calorie intake!"

He said that he has been paying for the fruit himself, and estimates the cost at R28,00 a year. I do not know whether you and Mrs Henderson would still like to contribute to the costs of this, but I would be grateful if you would let me know. If you feel you would like to cover the cost, it could be done either for a full year or else say, for six months. Again, the most convenient method might be to send me the cash and I shall then make arrangements with the Officer Commanding.

I look forward to hearing from you about this. In the meantime, my grateful thanks again to you for your help and friendship.
