4<sup>th</sup> Public Holidays. Sr. Mary's girls plastered all the huts in the Compound. At 8.30 am. Sister Superior & Fr. Robertson went into Tsole to meet Dr. Irving who has just returned from England, & who is going to help at the Hospital pro. tem. S. Eu. in retreat.

5<sup>th</sup> At 12.30 am. S. Sup. went into Tsole to meet Sr. Esme' who is coming here for a long rest. They returned at 1.45 as Sister had come on the Express bus. S.R.M. went to Hlaga to stay with the kindly fetched her. The Canon

6<sup>th</sup> Fr. Hubback finished her retreat this am. In the afternoon S.S. had a call took Sr. Esme' with her for the drive.

7<sup>th</sup> Fr. Hubback left at 2.30 am. taking Dr. Irving with her as far as Tsole: the latter is going to spend the weekend at M. Fere.

14<sup>th</sup> Weather cleared to day. Sr. V.R. & S.J.A. in retreat. S.S. to Umata at 10.30 am. to take Miss Atkoff, who fell down a couple of nights ago to the Hospital for X-Ray. Sr. Esme' went with her. They returned at 6.30 pm. with the news that Miss A had broken her leg above the knee & would probably be in Hospital a long time. Inter. school sports were held to day at Sr. Culbert's.

S.S. had a maternal call to Nomhala. S.J.A. accompanied here.
- 3<sup>m</sup> Miss R & Miss B. still examining. S.S. had a call to Sinxago in the afternoon. At 7.00 pm. the S<sup>r</sup> Mary's girls gave a good & varied entertainment.
- 4<sup>m</sup> The Inspectresses left this am. - All the Homecraft girls (2<sup>nd</sup> Year) passed their examinations. In the morning a Sale in aid of Red + was held in the School Hall. S<sup>r</sup>. Joseph's Concert in the pm.
- 6<sup>m</sup> S.I.B. concert in the pm.
- 7<sup>m</sup> Some girls went home to day - Mactear - & down the Umata line.
- F. of the Conception. 8<sup>m</sup> Schools closed to day. Lovers, both Kokstad & Umata, left soon after 8 am.  
V. Our Lady. S.S. taxed 3 children partway home, to just beyond Luxa bridge, taking S.H. with her for the drive.
- 10<sup>m</sup> Miss Moore left for her holiday this am. At 9 am. S.S. took 3 patients to Umata Hospital - (2 for X-ray -) S.H.C. & Jerevica went with her for the drive.
- 11<sup>m</sup> Workers' Mass meeting. Only one Mass on the Mission & all Sisters communicated at it.
- F. of S. Lucy. 13<sup>m</sup> All Sisters went to S. Lucy's Sung Mass at 6 am - we had talking am. tea in honour of S. Lucy & S.S. Profession Day & a happy party in the S. School room in the afternoon. S. Eu. came down to sleep.

15<sup>th</sup> S. Eu. had breakfast + am. tea in bed then went up to C.I.B. She is discontinuing her daily visit here at present as she finds the walk too tiring. Advent retreat (unconducted) began at 7.45 am.

16<sup>th</sup> Advent retreat: all Sisters took part except S. Euphemia.

17<sup>th</sup> Dr. Irving went to Attara for a few days, leaving here in the post lorry.

20<sup>th</sup> Mass at 6 am, followed by tea then 7 am. Sung mass at C.I.B. for the Clothing of 2 Novices. 8 P.M. to Beke for M.V. meetings.

F. S. Thomas 21<sup>st</sup> Dr. Irving returned from Attara in the afternoon.

23<sup>rd</sup> S.S. took a party of Sisters to Sparago for household shopping as stores had not come.

X'mas Eve. 24<sup>th</sup> A very busy day of preparations everywhere. Supper was at the ordinary time. Blessing of Crib + midnight mass at 11.30 pm - at which all our household communicated - + 15 of the Mission ladies. Fr. Young sang the mass + Altar was thurifer + server. Only 6 of the boarders came to sleep.

X'mas Day. 25<sup>th</sup> A very happy day. Frp Albridge + Frp Caine joined us at dinner. All at home on the Mission were invited to afternoon tea at 3.45 in the Refectory - after which we adjourned to the Crib for 2 carols. The King's Speech was at 5 - to which most of us listened before Solemn Vespers. Talking Supper in the refectory.

F. S. Stephen 26<sup>th</sup> S. Eu to Mass breakfast then to bed for the rest of the day - as she is v. tired + not well. We had a supper party in the Community room for S. Agnes Irene who leaves us to-morrow.

F. S. John 27<sup>th</sup> At 8.15. S.S. took S.A.T. to Tolo to begin her journey to Pretoria where she is now going to work. S.D. + S.V.R. went for the drive. S. Eu in bed all day.

F. S. Holy Innocents 28<sup>th</sup> S. Eu to Mass breakfast then to bed for day.

29<sup>th</sup> S. Eu in bed all day.

30<sup>th</sup> S. Eu up to am. tea - still afternoon tea.

31<sup>st</sup> S. Hilda Verily came (by lorry) for her rest. S.S. had a call to Nombala in the morning - had to go to Tolo in the pm. S. Eu up 10 am - 6 pm. Solemn Vespers of the following.
