House of Assembly, Friday.

POBERT SOBUKWE, a former Pan-Africanist Congress
eader who is serving a three-year jail term for inciting
arreans to campaign against the pass laws, will not receive
any remission of sentence, according to the Minister of
Justice, Mr. Vorster.

Replying to questions from Mr. M. L. Mitchell (U.P., Durban North), he said in the House of Assembly today that no remission was being granted "in view of the nature of the offence committed by him."

Sobukwe's full sentence ends on May 5.

### ANOTHER QUESTION

Mr. Vorster was asked if any further legal proceedings would be taken against Sobukwe after his release, or if he contemplated any action other than legal proceedings against him.

Mr. Vorster replied: "It is not considered in the public interest to furnish the information asked

for at this stage."
