## From the Editor's Desk.

Scouting seems to have lately been coupled on to  
some new high-power dynamo and is moving so fast  
that some of us are already out-of-breath with the  
effort of keeping up. "Gilwell" is hardly opened  
and now we are full speed ahead for Scout Week.  
Well, "let 'em all come!" But let us be quite sure  
in our own minds of the purpose at the back of  
these big projects. Not "swank" and self glorifica-  
tion; not advertisement; but increased efficiency and  
then increased numbers brought under the influence  
of the high ideals and aims of Scouting for Boys.

The proclamation by the Chief Scout for Africa,  
H. R. H. Prince Arthur, published herein, is a con-  
cise summing up of the whole matter, and the ap-  
peal for support will undoubtedly receive most  
favourable response, and the movement will no lon-  
ger be hampered at every turn for want of funds to  
carry Scouting into those areas where it is wanted  
most. We have to Be Prepared with MEN ready  
and devoted enough to take up work in those areas.  
Men of big vision; men whose souls are alive with  
the fires of Love for their fellows, and eager to fol-  
low the footsteps of The Master who as Man con-  
sorted with the Poor, the "publicans and sinners."  
World re-construction will not come from re-con-  
structing adults, but from re-building by properly  
moulding the plastic minds of the rising generation;  
impressing them with the ideals of Service, of Giv-  
ing of Love; by bringing them to a different concep-  
tion of the purpose of life and through Scouting liv-  
ing the summary of the whole law—Love God with  
all thy soul, mind, strength and thy neighbour as  
thyself.

The great Combined Church Parade on Sunday,  
October 15th, will be the first big gathering of  
Transvaal Scouts which H.R.H. will have had op-  
portunity of seeing. Further, it will be the first de-  
monstration to the thousands of new Associate Mem-  
bers we shall then have, of their associates; a demon-  
stration to them of the quality of the Brotherhood  
they have linked on to. There should be full  
strength parade of every Troop and Pack that day  
and the most scrupulous attention should be given to  
the details of dress, and to the Parade Orders. Our  
first appearance before the Chief and our new Mem-  
bers must create the most favourable impression.  
Suppose you read over again the details about uniform  
given in London Rules and see that your own uniform  
is correct.

We can expect to be tired, Scout Week means a  
strenuous time for all, but everyone must come up to  
scratch fresh and smiling on that Sunday for the cul-  
minating inspection, and to unite in thanks to God  
for the success which He has granted us, for the en-  
larged scope, the opened door, before us.
