1. ANC (Bevoni) refuses to work with SACPO.

2. Complaint by ANC that ^{when} the women were to go to Germiston on August 9th a transport have been provided from the funds of the Working Committee who are alleged to have ~~also~~ acquired money through the Fedⁿ Conference in March 1957. (Mrs Moody claims that all expenses for the conference were earned by SACPO women for the Fed. Conference)

3. She reports that the ANC ^(Bevoni) do not want to cooperate with the Fed. Working Committee ~~was~~ has been made up by Mrs S. S. (Seeⁿ. ANC W's League B) and put forward as the main reason for the poor ^{support} ~~attendance~~ of Bevoni women of the August 9th protest in Germiston.

4. ~~The~~ Mrs Moody reported that she was called by the ANC Bevoni Branch to give a report of the August 9th protest ^{at the} ~~Branch~~ ^{branch} ~~at the~~ ^{on Wednesday, August 14th.} meeting held in the Ntshabula Hall. - She did not attend because

- (1) she felt it was incorrect that she should be called to report
- (2) she has had difficulty in obtaining a permit to enter Bevoni before
