- The Championship will be held under I.T.T.F. Regulations and the current Laws of Table Tennis for International Competitions. Players are advised that the amended laws will be fully applied.
- All events, best of Three Games.
 Semi-finals and Finals, best of Five Games.
- Each match will be controlled by an Umpire, whose decision will be final on point of fact. The Referee's decision shall be final on point of Law.
- 4. Events 6 and 7 are open to boys and/or girls who had not attained the age of 17 prior to 1st January, 1975. The Chairman of the Union/Association submitting the entries shall scrutinise the ages of junior entrants and forward a certificate to the South African Table Tennis Board certifying that the junior entries conform to the age limit.
- Players shall not wear white or light-coloured clothing which might tend to unsight an opponent. The decision as to offence under this I.T.T.F. Regulation rests with the Referee.
- 6. Dunlop Barna 3 Crown balls will be used in all events.
- Players absent when called upon to play at any time, will render them selves liable to disqualification.
- 8. The Board reserves the right to restrict or refuse entries, and to hold a qualifying competition or competitions as may be necessary. Entries will be ignored without notification, unless accompanied by the full amount of fees due. Fees sent for entries subsequently rejected will be refunded.
- Players eliminated during the course of the Championship will be charged half the admission price (unreserved) on the night of the Finals on the production of their player's ticket.
