With reference to your letter dated the 22nd May, 1969 I have been directed by the Honourable the Minister of Justice to advise you that he has noted its contents.

The Honourable the Minister has directed me to assure you that no physical influences of any nature are being brought to bear upon you. Your complaints in this respect are completely unfounded and any further accusations of this sort cannot be entertained.

With reference to your statement that the report of the psychiatrists was not made available to you the Minister has directed me to advise you that they merely confirmed what you state in your letter to be the case namely that you are not a psychotic case. They found also that

1. your personality is intact;
2. your volition is intact;
3. your emotional responses are appropriate; and
4. your behaviour does not reflect a break with reality.
