Dear Mrs Moroka,

I could have written earlier to thank you and the doctor for the good reception we had at Taba Nc'u.

When I came to Durban I found Mrs Champion not well. I have been away for three weeks from Durban. I had promised to write or ring up the doctor about the holding of the meeting of the leaders. I had to see the Natal President before I write to him. These people do not wait that meeting to review the position but will carry on until the Annual Conference, that is the message.

This morning I have met Prince Yusruf who was with Mr Tema, he tells me that they met with accident with Mr Tema near Pietersburg when they nearly went over a goat. He came down here by himself without Mr Tema.

I hope you have had good rains in Taba Nc'u. Up to now I have not got any mealies.

Have you any potatoes out there two or three bags ?
