Catherine & Lena had a fight - Lena tried to walk out.

Christmas Eve married at S. Mary's in the afternoon.

24 A busy day. Superior & S.D.M. went to town to shop & get flowers & food. T. Huddleston came for Sisters' Confession at Muttongate 11.30 - but was late. S.R.M. in Church until time for T. H. <sup>in the church</sup> Hope & Victoria at side helped with flowers - continued with them all the afternoon.

27 S. John A.E. Boxing Day. Mass in Chapel 7 a.m. Olive & Shirley both absconded with their babies early in the morning. Police notified & called for details. All went to dinner at E.K. & morning T. Had to work hard at games! A very nice party.

28 Holy Innocents M.M.

S.D.M. took girls to the Bridgeman - S.R.M. & Hope redid flowers w house & church - a day of getting straight at home.

29 Sixth Day in Octave S. Thomas of Canterbury B.M.

Superior took Hope Pally to the Y.W. & went to the Bank. S.R.M. busy with Sunday Sch. babies party. Mother G. came back to Orlando to herding. S.D.M. went to Sephiatown S-affairs & E.K.

30 Sixth Day in Octave

Mother General came to Morning T. & stayed till after supper. Superior & S.R.M. had "times". S.D.M. took Marion Selina home after dinner, she had a 1 month holiday. Kathleen returned about 7. just as Mother was going.

31. Seventh Day in Octave.

Sisters went to herding for Mass & breakfast.

S.D.M. took girls to Baragwanath & drive. Hope Pally brought flowers for S.R.M. after morning T. they went over to the church & arranged flowers. Hope stayed for lunch &

3<sup>rd</sup> returned to the Y.W.C.A. after a train.

Sisters all went to Leesburg for Sisterly Party. Mother G. & Mother P. both there + 21 Sisters. Tea + Vespers.

January. 1955.

1. Circumcision of our Lord. New Years Day.

Mass in Chapel 6.30. Fr. Jenkins.

Mother G. came for morning T. Leesburg Sisters came for Vespers + Supper. + took Mother back after Supper.

Girls had a party in the evening - games + ves + swats.

2 Sunday. Octave Day of St. Stephen. Mass 6 + 8 a.m. S. Mary's.

Many visitors to see girls. Sunday classes as usual for S.R.M.

Superior took S.D.M. to Hospital for check up returned about 4 p.m. to find that Lydia had "walked out". Superior went to her Gramy's house in Orlando - Lydia had been there + left. Superior was given several addresses - eventually found her + brought her back - after 4 hrs returning here 8.15. At 11.30 p.m. S.R.M. heard screams + great commotion in dormitories - a man was trying to get in through barred window - legs + body through - but couldnt get head + shoulders. Police phoned - took  $\frac{3}{4}$  hrs to come. Then chased away from dormitory but prowled round the house peering thru' windows + trying doors. Slept off when police came + 2.20 - searched all round - slept watch through the night.

C.R. Fathers in Retreat at D.S.G. Pekonia till Sat.

3<sup>rd</sup> Octave Day St John.

Superior took girls to Bridgeman + went to E.K. in the morning.

Called on Mrs Davis + Olive + Shirley. Police came 10.30.

4. Superior took Olive + Shirley to Social Welfare - the Roads went to In the afternoon Superior + S.R.M. fetched vegetable from Soc. Aff. went on to visit S.D.M. in Hospital. Fetched Olive + Shirley's children, then went to look for Sophie NK. who had not returned from the clinic, nor was she at the Barragwanath. Police came at 10.30 till 6 a.m.

5. Superior went to Pinville to fetch Sophie from her granmgs.
