Sat: June 14th

S^{rs} Euphemia, Rachel Lu, Luonca Lu, Violet Ruth
and Miss Wallace arrived, motored by
S. Lu. Lu. from S. Cutbert's. After tea
about 4 p.m. a brief visit by car to
Skelley beach, leaving the car on
return at Miss Whitaker's Garage.
After supper all went to the library.

Sun: June 15th

All to Mass at 8. After breakfast
some went for walks, others
reading - writing etc. - resting in
the p.m. Miss Wallace to S. Savion's
to Svenson, S. Eu. & S. V. R. to
S. Peter's. S. Lu. Lu. early to bed.

Tues: June 16th

Breakfast at 8 a.m. S. Lu. Lu. rest
morning. All to Skelley beach by car
after morning tea, weather and all
conditions perfect, returning at 4 p.m.
Geyser had not functioned on ²⁰ arrival
but was now in order, after
tea bath. began in earnest, an
anxious queue outside the doors!
Some to Church for Vespers etc

Tue: June 17th

Miss Wallace and S. Eu. breakfast in bed.

After morning tea S. Lu. Lu. motored all to town, separating, Miss W. and S. R. M. to meet Miss Atkinson and Miss Huskisson arriving by train, others to shop, the two former having mid-day meal at G.W.C.A., others coffee and loaf at Gorticke. This morning, rain in afternoon, home to tea with many purchases, to find Harold Sheppard had called leaving the 'Wireless', a gift from S. Rachel's brother to C.S.H.V. at S.C.O. Truck and unpacking and showing off purchases and readjusting into smaller compass so as to pack into car on return journey.

Wed: June 16th All to town at 7 a.m. Wet and cold. Writing and reading most of morning, Miss W. and S. Lu. Lu. for walk after morning tea. H. Sheppard called about the Wireless as dinner was finished and took all but S. Eu: into town in his car, to continue the shopping.

Thurs: June 19th S. R. M. and S. V. R. in bed for breakfast. Surely bright day but windy and rather cold. Miss W. S. Lu. Lu. and S. V. R. went for a picnic in Sighthouse direction after morning tea. S. Eu: and S. R. Lu. for a walk and

read on the rocks and home to dinner.
After tea S. L. L. motored all to Y.W.C.A.,
picked up Miss Atchoppe and Miss Hustrisson
thence for a lovely drive on the Grand
Prix road, home through the town,
visiting the penguins and sea lions.
After a brief pause S. L. L. again set

Tue: June 24th Mass at 7 a.m. S^{rs} R. & M. in bed all day with

Wed: June 25th Mass at 7 a.m. S^{rs} R. & L. in bed to
breakfast. All others to town ^{in Miss Morrison} to finish
shopping, call for typewriter for F. Sup^r
from Mrs Bowen, and morning tea in
Lucrecia Glen. Hereby hangs a tale !!!
Home - picking up S^{rs} Rachel and dinner,
and off in Miss Morrison to Skelley Beach
tea at home, most of the evening spent
in packing Miss Morrison in readiness
for her return to Sr C's the following day
Hereby hangs another tale !!

Thurs: June 26th S^{rs} E. L. and Miss Wallace left for S. Cutbert's at 9 a.m. in Miss Morrison, calling at G.W.C.A. for Miss Atkings and Miss Huskisson. After morning tea the remaining four walked up Lighthouse Hill, picnic dinner there, lovely morning, cloudy and cold in afternoon. S^{rs} E. and S^r R. L. called on Miss Whitaker but she was out. S^r E. Dorcas supper in bed.

Fri: June 27th Mass 7 a.m. Very cold, windy and stormy, stayed at home to write, read etc. S^r V. R. and S^r E. D. for steep walk to Lighthouse to buy and get warm. S^{rs} E. and S^r V. R. supper in bed.

Sat: June 28th S^{rs} E. and S^r R. L. to town by bus, shopping, booking seats for return journey. S. V. R. and S^r E. D. walked to town and back getting a 'lift' both ways, visited monkeys and peacocks. Called on Miss Whitaker in the evening. S^{rs} E. and S^r V. R. to Library at 7.30.

Sunday June 29th Mass 8 a.m. S^r V. R. and S^r E. D. to rocks
Patronal Festival in morning. S^{rs} E., S^r R. L. S^r E. D. to Sewing.

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Mon: June 30th S^r. R.M. and S^r. V.R. went to the dentist, S^r. Eu: and S^r. E.D. to the rocks after morning tea, all home to dinner. Mrs and Miss Stomou came to tea. S^r. E.D. and S^r. V.R. supper in bed.

Tue: July 1st All four Sisters in Retreat. After morning tea each collected sandwiches and found her own place of Retreat, returning with wild flowers for Our Lady's Festival. Festival Vespers in Graloria at 6.15. p.m.

Wed: July 2nd Hours of Visitation of B.V.M. All four walked to Shelley Beach, S^r. Eu: and S^r. V.R. starting soon after breakfast getting proper time and tea a.m. there (i.e. oranges and biscuits) the other two following after ditto at home, and getting a 'lift' most of the way. Returned for tea. p.m. S^r. Eu: and S^r. R.M. supper in bed.

Thur: July 3rd S^r. R.M. S^r. E.D. and S^r. V.R. to town, shopping tea. a.m. in Queen's park, returning mid-day. Mrs Sestie to tea. p.m. S^r. E.D. and S^r. V.R. supper in bed. Mrs Leonard, and two daughters came to

see S^r Eu: after supper.

Fri: July 4th Mass at 7. All to rocks taking fruit etc returning for mid-day meal. S^r E.D. and S^r V.R. out again in afternoon. S^r Eu: and S^r R.M. in bed for supper.

Sat: July 5th After tea a.m. all started for Balé Cave, taking 'bus to Lukt Place, then to Beach. Then walking for an hour before reaching the summit. A glorious place! S^r Eu: stayed there while the others went beyond towards Takoon after a picnic lunch by the seat near the top. Returning Sisters V.R. and E.D. walked all the way to Lukt Place so as to visit the penguins, S^r Eu: and S^r R.L. by 'bus. After supper S^r R.L. and S^r V.R. to Library.

Sun: July 6th Mass 8 a.m. Sisters R.M., E.D. and V.R. to the rocks until dinner, all at home in the p.m. writing letters. S^r Eu: and R.M. to Evening.
