Memorandum of an Agreement of Lease made and entered into at Mafeking, Bechuanaland, Cape Province on this the date of 24th January 1913. Between Galshele Montsioa of Mafeking aforesaid here - in after styled the lessor of the one part. And Sundel Gordon also of Mafeking aforesaid hereinafter styled the lessee of the other part - The Lessor who is the transferee of the Farm Davendale by paying the quit-rent and the raki taxes on behalf of my late Son Badirile Montsioa's Children, hereby lets to the lessee who hereby hires from me the Farm Davendale. The rental due and payable by the Lessee to the Lessor and to open a well of thirty feet deep in respect of the Property hereby leased. And shall the Sum of £18. Eighteen Pounds ~~Shillings~~. Per Annum be payable yearly in advance on the 25th day of January, every year during currency of this lease. The period of Lease shall be Five Years. On expiry the -
