I now have the pleasure to inform you that I have been adviced by the Secretary for Justice as follows:

"With reference to your letter of 3rd February, 1975 it is pointed out that none of the disqualifications referred to in Section 5(quat)(1) of the Su pression of Communist Act, 1950 (Act 44 of 1950) is applicable to Mr. Sobukwe. It is consequently not clear why the court will require a written statement by the Honourable the Minister of Justice that he has no objection to Mr. Sobukwe's admission as an attorney.

For your information it may be mentioned that the Minister has decided to mithdraw the prohibition prohibiting Mr. Sobukwe from entering court premises. A notice to this effect will be delivered to him in due course."
