I received your letter. The letter's arrival coincided with happenings I feared would come about. I once told them to Chief Lekoko and he said he is still considering. I would be grateful if you can ask him to help just with £100. He would by this lessen my fears and encourage me to help you more freely.

If I can just borrow £100 and pay 7 per cent my mind would be easy and things can go on a bit. Please plead with him on my behalf. Indeed when I saw your letter I was hopeful. Plead with him to help me as soon as possible for I fear those who want their increase my deep anxieties and they may spoil a project that has a promising future.

Kind regards. Please help and the trip will be alright and we will endeavour by all means to help the Barolong.
