20. Miss Rose spent the day here in retreat. In the p.m. Nurse Larase was given <sup>the certificate at 5.45 -</sup>
21. In the afternoon S.S. took S.R. & 3 other Sisters to Spang's
22. S.R. to am. tea at <sup>Kear</sup> Guest Cottage soon to leaving school: in the afternoon S.R. M. took her visiting - they had tea at a kraal. S.S. took the Hoop. car
23. into Tolo in the am. returned with Dr. Meares.

- 7<sup>m</sup> A fine day for 'this day of days'. At 12.5 noon S. Superior, accompanied by S<sup>r</sup>. Eu., drove to Tolo to meet the Rev. Mother General - coming from Pretoria. They returned at 1.45 - Sisters only met them at the gate. A talking afternoon & talking tea on the stoep, after which all went over to the Hostel where the girls welcomed Mother with a greeting song on the terraces. Sung Vespers at 5 pm. followed by Te Deum - after which the Rev. Mother accompanied S<sup>r</sup>. Eu. to C.D. J.B.
- 8<sup>m</sup> Rev. Mother saw over the Hospital in the am. S<sup>r</sup> Superior & J. Rumsey called on her in the am. & pm. respectively.
- 9<sup>m</sup> Devotions at 5 pm. followed by Solemn Vespers of the F. of the Dedication.
- For the Dedie<sup>n</sup>. 10<sup>m</sup> 6.20 am. Sung Mass - at which Arthur served. S.S. to Tolo in the Ambulance in the afternoon.
- 12<sup>m</sup> Mother to leaving school in the morning to tea in the Parlour in the afternoon. Standard 1 exams began: we have 15 boarders in 1. Miss Peddie arrived for Horsecraft Inspection & Exam<sup>n</sup>.
13. Miss Peddie examining.
- 14 Miss Peddie examining. Mother to C.D. J.B. school in the am. S.S. to Chjeni in the afternoon with the Ambulance.
15. S.S. in retreat, was in bed from breakfast onwards because of laryngitis. Mother went up to C.D. J.B. after am. tea for the rest of the day. Miss Peddie took S.R. & S. Tabitha to see Miss Rowe's School at the Tabuto, after dinner.
16. S<sup>r</sup>. Eu. in retreat. Mother went out sketching in the am. A few days ago we heard by post that the Assistant Superior was in the Nursing Home with rheumatic

Drew was picked up in Tolo. Pictures in the p.m. - a good show.
- 20<sup>m</sup> Rev. Mother in retreat. S.R.M. had women's Meeting.
- 21<sup>d</sup> Mother to Tolo by post lorry with S<sup>r</sup> Euphemia in the am.  
In the afternoon the children gave a display of Morris & Country  
dancing on the Terrace. S.S. to Mtshigo in the Ambulance in  
the afternoon.
- 22<sup>f</sup> Telegram from Mother P. telling us that the Assistant's illness is now  
diagnosed as enteric fever. Nurses' entertainment in the evening  
as in the Dormitory of the Nurses' Home: very good indeed.
- 23<sup>s</sup> S.D. Helen in retreat.
- 24<sup>m</sup> Dinner picnic to the famous spot above the Mjwenka forest station.  
Mother, S.S. (driving) S.D. S.H. & S.R.M. - a lovely treat. In the  
evening S<sup>r</sup> Mary's Hostel concert - which was v. good & varied  
& not too long.
- 25<sup>m</sup> Miss Tillard to sea. Rev. William Means, late of Shawbury, died in Unyata to-day.
- 26<sup>m</sup> S.S. - accompanied by S.H. - to Tolo in the am. for petrol. Directly after  
dinner she went out on a call, up the Mjwenka, taking Mother for the drive.
- 27<sup>m</sup> S.H.C. in retreat. At 1pm. a party set out for Mbokotwana, Shawbury  
for Mr. Means funeral - S.S. driving, Mother & S. Eu for Mbokotwana,  
Dr. Rumsey & Mr. Ludidi for Shawbury. After depositing Mother & S. Eu at Mbokotwana  
the car broke down. Dr. Rumsey & Mr. Ludidi walked to the main road & got  
picked up & so to the funeral. S.S. tried to mend the car but failed. Mr. Payne  
kindly picked up all in his car on the return journey to Tolo, from whence  
they returned in <sup>Sheppard's</sup> the Garage car - which A. Sheppard went to  
the Hospital car stranded on the veldt.
- 28<sup>m</sup> S.S. returned the Garage car, then came out with Dr. Means &

- Nov: 28<sup>th</sup> M<sup>rs</sup>. Means, he for work at St. Luys - she to see Mother.  
 29<sup>th</sup> Soon after 11 am. Mother took Miss Morrison out to Spang's with S.F.M. S.D.H. S.H.C + S.H.V for shopping. No adventures except for one stop on the outward journey. Thunder rain in the pm.  
 Dec: 30<sup>th</sup> At 7.30 pm the Seniors gave a v. good play for Mother - "The King's Crown" written & produced by S<sup>r</sup>. Dorothea.

- 1<sup>st</sup> Mother drove P<sup>r</sup>. Irving into To'lo for the Kokstad bus - she is going to spend the weekend with the Hazelwoods. Plays in the pm. (see above.)  
Advent 2<sup>nd</sup> A wet day. At 7.30 pm. Mother & most of the Sisters went up to Cl. J. B. to see acted Cantos, which were most beautifully & reverently done.  
Sunday 3<sup>rd</sup> The Bishop came out + called on Mother at 1.45. M<sup>rs</sup> Gibson came with him. Good rain at intervals.  
 4<sup>th</sup> In the am. Mother saw a good many people on the mission, in the afternoon she gave away the Homecraft School prizes, saw over St. Josephs, went up to recreation at Cl. J. B. to present a postulant for admission. In the evening she gave the Hostel prizes here. A wet day.  
 5<sup>th</sup> At 8.15. the Mission car, going in to take away Canon Streetfield who has been visiting here, came down for Mother + S. Superior. Mother caught the Kokstad bus en route for Irene. Hospital Committee meeting at 11.30 am. A wet day. some girls left for E. London + To'burg.  
 6<sup>th</sup> Boarders began to disperse - the Matricule ones early in the am. - some by + a lorry load for main line train after dinner. weather clearing.  
 7<sup>th</sup> Schools closed. bus leaves at 5 am 6.30, 10. am + 2 pm.  
First Conception 8<sup>th</sup> 6. am. Mass in our Chapel 7. am. Workers' Mass 9.45 am.  
B.V.M. 8<sup>th</sup> Workers' meeting.  
 10<sup>th</sup> S.R. M to Beck for M.V. meeting in the am. S. Superior had a call to Hopedale in the afternoon.  
 11<sup>th</sup> S. Euphemia came down for the <sup>Annual</sup> retreat which began with 1<sup>st</sup> Address at 7.45 pm. Conductor F<sup>r</sup> Hill S.S.T.E (The Rev. F<sup>r</sup> Superior.) All the Sisters were able to take part except S. Hulda Kerily in the absence of another European nurse at S. Lucy's.  
 12-15<sup>th</sup> Annual Retreat.

- Adventiv: 16 Retreat ended at this am. Trip Wolfe came to tea.
- 18 Dr. Irving went to Umtata for the night. Mr. Cica came to visit the Hospital + view the site before proceeding further with plans. Miss Preston arrived from Grace Dieu to spend X'mass.
- 19 S.S. to Tolo for petrol - to bring Dr. Irving back - In the evening at 6.30 pm. The Bethlehem Tableaux were given in Church. The performers were Teachers + mistresses mainly - helped by a few children. The stage was in the centre of the Church instead of the side aisle.
- 24<sup>th</sup> A very busy day. S.D.S.H. did the Crib in Chapel, St. C. flowers - S. Eu came down to sleep for 3 nights - Compline was at 8.15 - Night Hours at 10. pm (rather too early -) Midnight Mass was sung by Dr. Superior this year - served by 2 of his home boys.
- Monday. All as usual - Tea for all Europeans in the afternoon - at 3.45 - Twenty eight came, rather fewer than usual, as a good many are away St. Key is sick. Carols 2 + 3. N.D. were sung in Chapel after tea, then our guests went to the King's Speech St. Young gave us Solemn Vespers. Ladies were out for supper + Sisters talked in the Refectory.
20. S. Superior took a patient home to the Mtwenka after dinner: S.D.H. Miss Preston went with her for the drive. C.S.D.B. Tree + party in the evening.
27. S.S. had a call to the Mtwenka in the afternoon. At 5.30 the Nurses gave an impromptu concert to the patients.
28. St. Key, who has been ill since just before Christmas was brought into S. Lucy's.
29. At 12.20. S.S. accompanied by S.D. went to Tolo to meet St. Editha who is coming for her rest.
- 30<sup>th</sup> Miss Wallace to Tea. St. F.M. + S.R.M. to bed early, unwell.
- 31<sup>st</sup> S.F.M. + S.R.M. both in bed for breakfast, but up later in the day for a while.
